a. Saichiro Soeda, having been born in Japan, is a Japanese citizen.

b. Toshio Soeda, having been born in the United States, is an American citizen.

2. Therefore, in answer to:

a. Question 1--Saichiro Soeda is a Japanese citizen and Toshio Soeda is an American citizen.

b. Question 2--Paragraph 1a, SCAPIN 777, dated 26 February 1946, provides that the Japanese courts will exercise no civil jurisdiction "with respect to United Nations nationals or organizations (including corporations) attached to or accompanying the allied armed forces." Saichiro Soeda and Toshio Soeda are not attached to the allied armed forces, and so do not fall within this provision. Paragraph 2a of SCAPIN 777 provides that "decisions in all civil cases affecting other United Nations, nationals, or organizations, or in which such nationals or organizations are or may become parties shall be subject to review." Toshio Soeda falls within this provision. The Otsu Family Court has jurisdiction in this civil case, involving as it does one Japanese citizen and one American citizen not attached to or accompanying the allied armed forces.
