

PLAN OF FUJIKOSHI

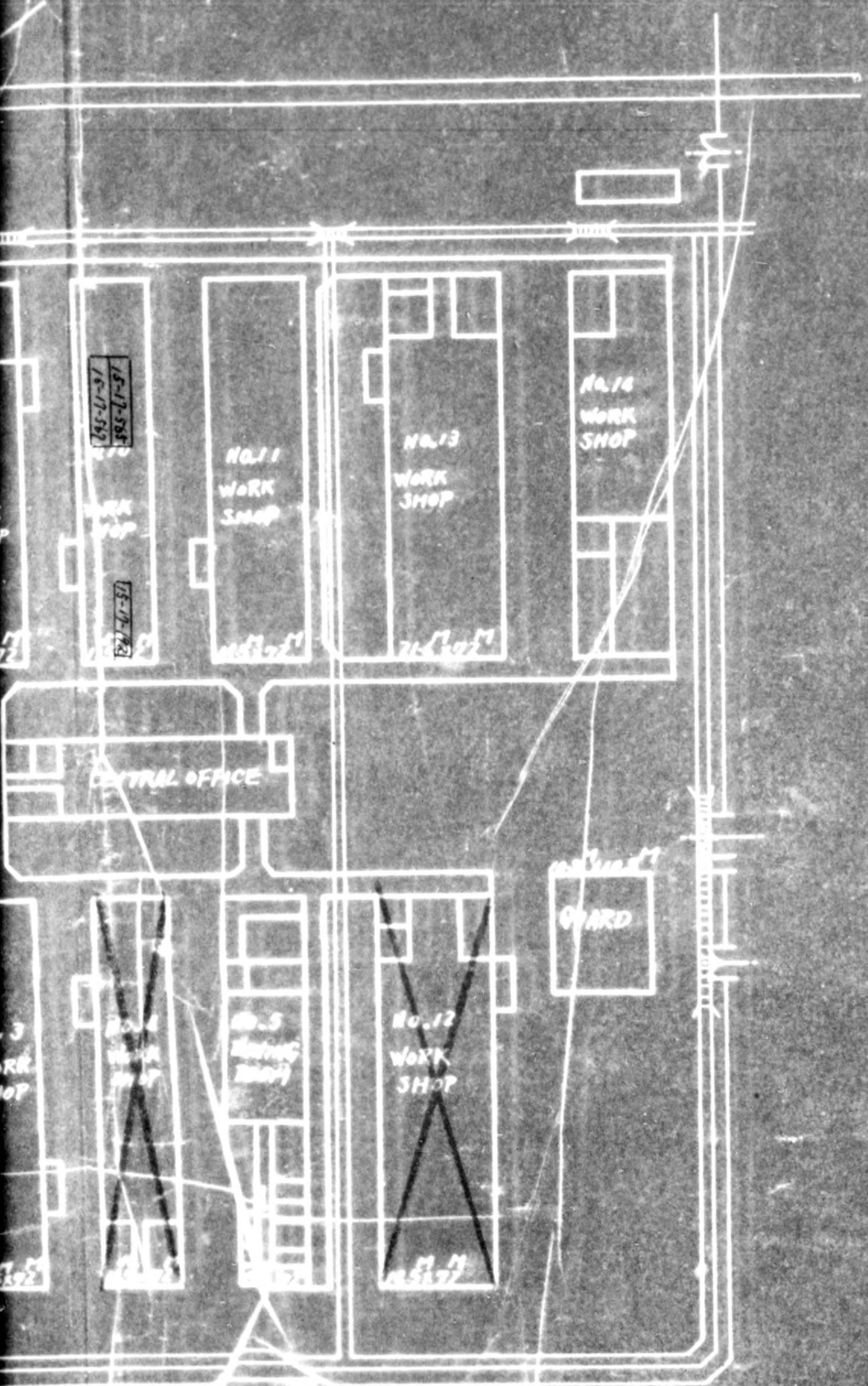

I. Land Problem

Reparation machines are stored in 5 buildings in the compound of 6791 tsubo which is surrounded by the first fence. (refer to the plan of the plant) Between the first and second fences there is 1930 tsubo land without cultivation.

Outside the second fence there is 1394 tsubo land which is now being cultivated by the employees. The above three lands belong to the Fujikoshi Kozai KK.

Besides the above three there is 19,114 tsubo land which formerly belonged to the reparations plant and now belongs to the central government by decision of the farm land commission. This land is not sold to the farmers yet because the committee does not decide yet whom it should be sold to.

This land has been cultivated by many people without permit or in some cases by force. The company does not know these cultivators' names. The company of course has not got any land tax in kind from them. The plant asked the town office to get the money from the farmers at least equal to the amount of tax paid by the company but no answer has been got yet because even the town office does not know the names of the cultivators. But they know 430 tsubo out of 19,114 tsubo is cultivated by the company's employees.

This big area of 19,114 tsubo is now belonging to the central government and so the Hakui plant has nothing to do with this land at present. I investigated chiefly on why 1930 tsubo land between the 2 fences has not been cultivated until today.

About 2.5 years ago when Captain Cordell was in charge of reparation plants Kencho told the plant to keep the people away from the buildings by 20 ken (120 ft.) and the plant got some budget from the central government and made the first fence and prevented the people from getting in contact with the building.

In that time the company retained the 1930 tsubo area just outside the first fence and about the same area in front of the buildings along the public road.

Although the employees wished to cultivate these lands the company did not allow them to cultivate these lands on purpose. If the CAT recommends the utilization of the above land the company will willingly land it to his employees.

By the way I shall describe here what I heard about the big area of 19,114 tsubo. There is another 240 tsubo of building land in front of the guard house at opposite side of the public road. The total area is 19,114 + 240 = 19,354 tsubo. This land was sold on either 2 July or 2 Oct. 1948 to the central government according to the farm land adjustment law and the money was already paid to the company but the registration is not finished yet. The farm land committee does not know which is the best way to sell the land to either the present cultivators or the former land owners. This land was bought by the company at a very low price during the war almost compulsorily.

The present cultivators have no relations arising from a lessor and lessee so they have no right to buy.

Mr. Kamatani who was newly elected on 25 Aug. for the chairman of the farm land committee will shape his course by conferring with the committee.

2. Removed of Machines

The present condition of the storing is as follows.

No. 1 building	232 machine tools
No. 2 "	229 " "
No. 3 "	23 furnances chiefly
No. 4 "	15 heavy machine
No. 5 "	141 machine tools

The plant does not intend to move the machines at present but if some body for example the neighboring weaving plant wishes to utilize the building, two buildings No. 1 and No. 2 can be emptied and those machines in the two buildings can be stored in the other 3 buildings without difficulty. The cost of moving them of course must be paid by the person who wants the buildings.

The Hakui plant did not know if there was somebody who wanted to use the buildings. But if some body happens to utilize the buildings the plant will negotiate with him with favor. I met the managing director Mr. Kamatani of the Morita weaving plant and found he had some plan of extending his plant in the future.

Formerly he ~~move~~ 100% export Habutae but after mass cancellation of export goods he has been weaving 60% Habutae for export and 40% Habutae for domestic use. He has now 79 power looms in operation and 30 looms which are now being assembled.

So in the near future he will have 109 looms in operation. In addition to this he is going to extend his plant so as to operate 250 machines altogether and also intends to have a dormitory.

3. Critical Materials

The plant reported to have had 59,217 Kgs of ordinary steel and 28,009 Kgs of the stock was sold by ticket issued from the Min. of Com. & Ind. and the rest, 31,208 Kgs was approved to retain in the main plant in Toyama and was transported to the Toyama plant in March 1949.

The plant reported also that he had had 11,323 Kgs of special steel which was needed to report. No instruction on this material was received yet.

9851 Kg of cast iron scrap which had been reported was transported to the main plant by the ticket issued in Dec 1948.

65,833 Kgs of steel scrap was reported but only 8,000 Kgs was contracted with the Industry Rehabilitation Kodan.

For the above scraps the plant has got an order to sell 18,000 Kgs to Kodan and Kodan inspected the materials and made contract for only 8,000 Kg in May 1949 as described above.

The Kodan did not want to buy the rest of them.

195 Kgs of nail was in the plant on 31 March 1948 and 85 Kgs was sold by ticket in Dec 1948 and 95 Kgs was used and 13 Kgs is still retained in the ware-house.

The plant also had 8,849 Kgs of pig iron and it was transported to the Toyama Main plant by ticket in Dec 1949.

The plant had many kinds of oils totalling 1671 Kgs of semi solid oils and 5647 liters of petroleum products.

Some of them were used in cleaning the reparation machines and the plant is now negotiating with the trade & industry Ministry if the main plant can use them or not.

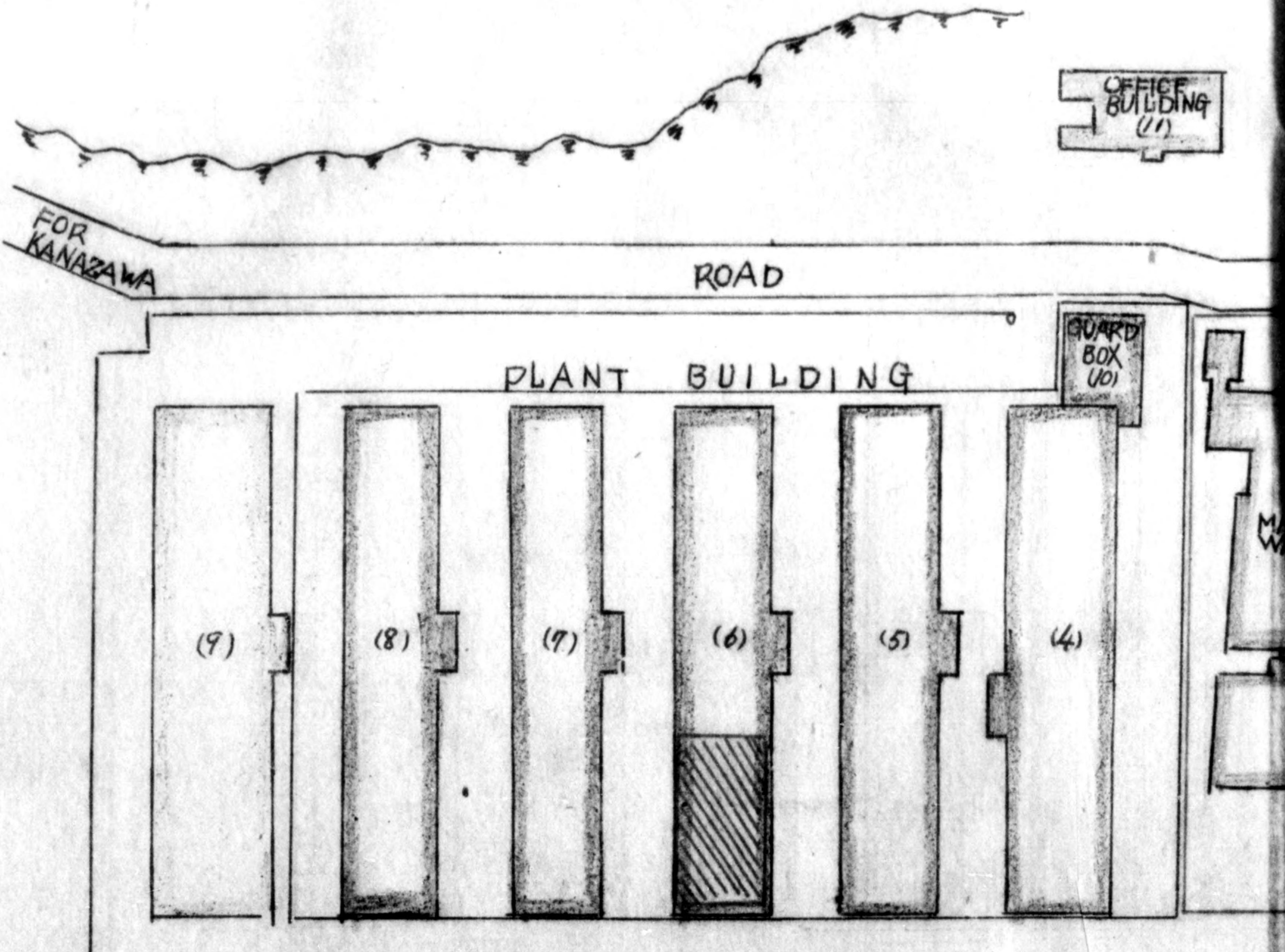

PLANT BUILDING

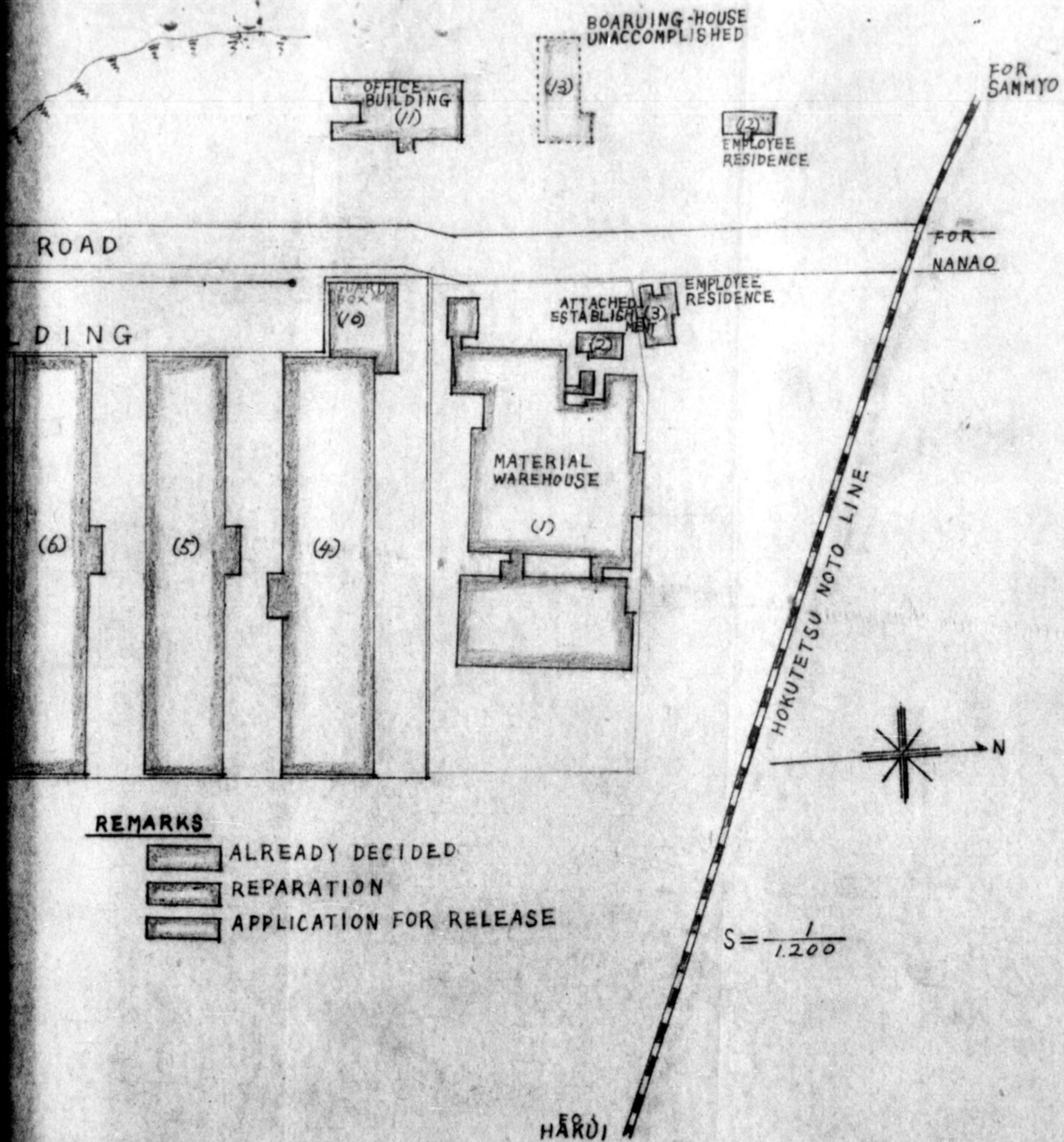
