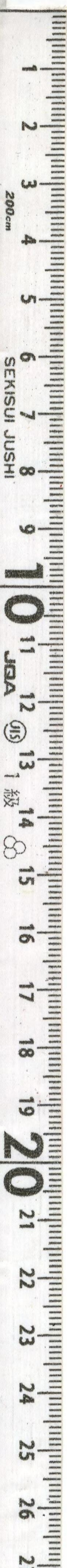

MEMORANDUM FOR: General Mudgett

SUBJECT: Greek C-47 Air Accident

The following was reported from FEAF by the Army Liaison Officer (Lt Col Brainerd) at 0850I this date:

A Greek courier plane, C-47, crashed on takeoff in vicinity of K10, DP7388, southeast of Masan and west of Pusan, at 270325 December. The aircraft apparently lost the left engine after becoming airborne and crashed into a small knoll about two miles south of the field. Aircraft exploded on contact and burned; weather was clear. There were 14 persons aboard and nationality of individuals is unknown at this time; no survivors.

The above is a preliminary flash report; investigation is being conducted by 5th Air Force.

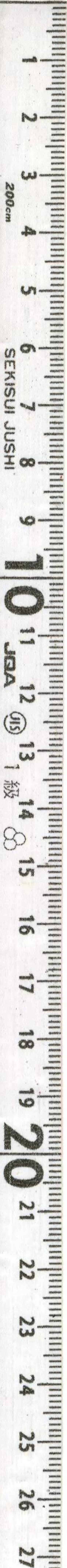

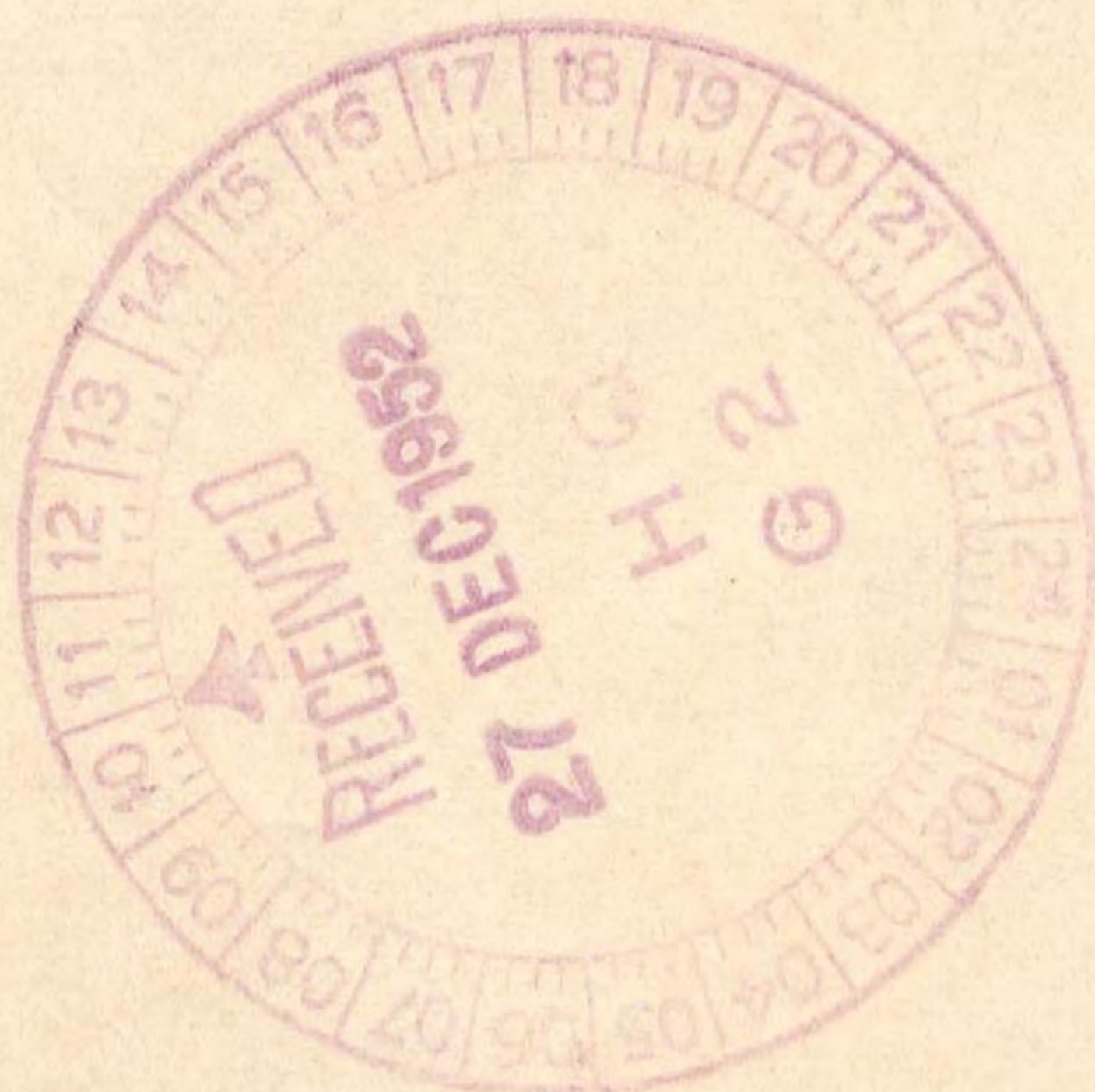

conducted by 5th Air Force.

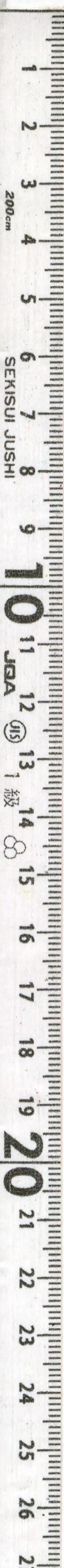

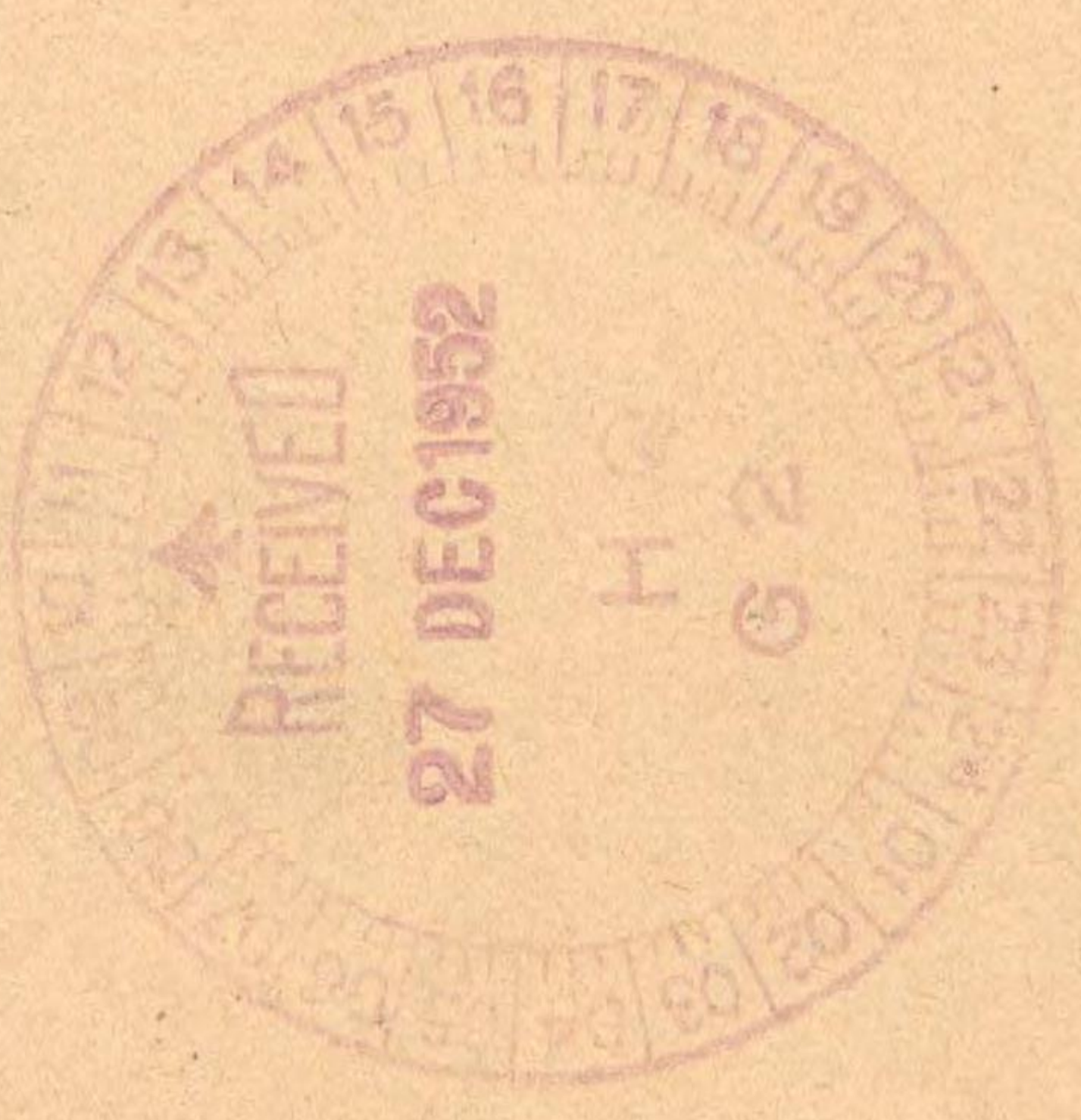
