The bonds will carry 5 per cent interest and be payable in both Canada and New York. Tenders are asked on five and twenty-three year terms.

Strawberry growers of the Saanich Peninsula will this year receive a price with a substantial advance in price over that of their year of work, compared with the results which would have accrued except for the recent frosting of the plants.

Not Half Expected Output. The output is expected to total about 1,400,000 pounds. Instead of three million, as was last fall conservatively estimated as a reasonable crop.

Heavy Frost Cuts. While normal returns average three tons per acre on good plots, this year the Gordon Head farmers will not average more than one ton, though favored plots may approach the two ton mark.

ONTARIO TO FUND MOTOR FEES TO BUILD HIGHWAYS

Toronto, May 17.—The plan of the Ontario Motor Vehicle Association will be held in the Dominion Hotel at 6:30 o'clock this evening.

On several occasions the Ontario Motor League has urged the government to adopt the scheme of capitalizing a portion of the revenue anticipated from motor vehicle license fees to provide funds for the building of the Provincial Highways.

The revenue from motor vehicle license fees last year was approximately \$3,000,000. This revenue is increasing from year to year and if \$2,000,000 annually is set aside by means of a bond issue for construction work, there will be upwards of \$1,000,000 remaining each year to provide for maintenance.

WHEAT MARKETING AGENCY IS PLAN

Recommendation Made to Parliament by Committee Ottawa, May 17.—(Canadian Press) The passage of an act creating a national wheat marketing agency with powers similar to those of the Canada Wheat Board of 1919, and to become effective when two or more of the provinces have conferred upon this agency powers possessed by the late Wheat Board, was recommended to Parliament to-day by the House Committee on Agriculture.

This action was taken as a result of a resolution introduced by R. M. Johnston, Progressive, Moose Jaw, and was approved on a vote of 32 to 28.

Mr. Johnston's resolution as adopted by the committee provides that the new wheat marketing agency be given all such powers of the Wheat Board of 1919 as are within the jurisdiction of Parliament to grant, and that an act be passed, based on this resolution, to become effective by proclamation as soon as two or more of the provinces have conferred upon this agency such powers possessed by the Wheat Board of 1919 as come within their jurisdiction.
