**1. INTRODUCTION.** A trade and traffic census was conducted throughout Western Nigeria for approximately five full days (Thursday 24th to Saturday 26th February and Monday 28th February to Wednesday 2nd March, 1966). It was conducted jointly by the Highways Division of the Ministry of Works and Transport, the Nigerian Institute of Social and Economic Research, the Ove Arup and Partners (a firm of civil Engineers on behalf of the Economist Intelligence Unit of London) and the Statistics Division of the Ministry of Economic Planning and Social Development.

**2.1. THE OBJECTIVE.** The main objective of the census was to measure the flow of traffic within Western Nigeria as well as between the region<sup>1</sup> and the other regions of Nigeria.

**2.2** The Ministry of Works and Transport and the Ove Arup and Partners were particularly interested in the flow of vehicles with a view to ascertaining the volume of traffic, and consequently, the relative importance of the numerous roads within Western Nigeria in order to determine which of the roads deserve prior attention. On the other hand, the Nigerian Institute of Social and Economic Research and this Division were primarily interested in the flow of goods with a view to measuring the volume of intra—as well as inter-regional trade.

**2.3** This report, is devoted mainly to the analysis of the flow of goods within Western Nigeria as well as between the region and the other regions of the country.

**3.1 PRE-CENSUS ARRANGEMENTS.** Prior to the actual census, a pilot survey was carried out for six days (16th to 18th December and 21st to 23rd December, 1965) at the following four census points, namely a place near Ibadan on Ibadan-Iwo road, another point near Owode in Egba Division, a third point near Ogbomosho and a fourth point near Igboora.

**3.2** For the pilot survey, the services of well-trained enumerators were employed and were supervised by two senior members of staff of the Ove Arup and Partners.

**3.3** The purpose of the pilot survey was to test our arrangements for the main survey, to study the reactions of the drivers who were to be the informants and to see whether our questionnaire would infact elicit the expected answers. Experiences gained from the pilot survey furnished the basis for the considerable improvements made in the final arrangements.

**4. THE QUESTIONNAIRE.** The questionnaire used was a simple and easy one to fill. It contained simple questions about type, make, weight and registration number of vehicles, journey origin and destination, number of passengers carried and type, weight and value of goods carried. (*see appendix 1 for a specimen questionnaire*).

**5.1 THE ACTUAL COUNT.** 120 enumerators were employed to take part in the actual count which was conducted at thirty-three census points spread all over the former Western Nigeria. (*see appendix 2 for the list of census points*).

**5.2** A group of six enumerators constituted a team and the work of enumeration at each point was done by one team except a few very busy census points like the ones at Owo/Ifon, Ijebu-Ode/Idiayunre, Ikorodu/Shagamu, etc., where two teams worked.

**5.3** Each day of the survey was divided into three equal shifts, namely 6.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m., 2.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m. to 6.00 a.m. Each team of six was similarly divided into three sub-groups of two enumerators each to coincide

with the number of shifts. This made it possible to conduct the survey round the clock and non-stop from 6.00 a.m. the first day till 6.00 p.m. the third day. The change-over from shift to shift was very smoothly arranged and no enumerator was to leave the census point until the one taking-over from him had properly resumed work.

**6.1 ANALYSIS AND TABULATION.** The figures published in this report are annual estimates based on the five-day survey. The estimation procedures are as follows:

**6.2** Two sets of raising factors were used—the raising factor for movement from North to West, and from West to North; movement between all other regions as well as between divisions within the West.

(i) The raising factor used in estimating the aggregate flow of traffic between North and West was derived from the equation:

$$P = 12 \left\{ \frac{KN}{\sum (x_1 + x_2 + \dots + x_n)} \right\}$$

where P, the raising factor is equal to the ratio between the February value of inter-regional road traffic flow (K) between the Northern and Western regions, estimated from the Survey data and the average value of traffic hauled by the railway transport system for the same month of February over the past N years multiplied by 12; x denotes the value of traffic carried by the railway transport service in the month of February for each of the years 1 to N where N is equal to 5:

(ii) *West to North.* Similar exercise as above was undertaken for West to North movement figures.

(iii) *Others:* (i.e., other regional movements apart from (i) and (ii) above as well as estimates of inter-divisional movements in the West): We have no returns showing movement of goods by rail as we have in (i) and (ii) above. So, we simply divide an average month of thirty days by the number of days (5) for which the survey lasted and then multiplied the dividend by 12. No adjustments were made for seasonal fluctuations for want of an adequate basis for such adjustments.

These factors were used to 'blow up' the original tables that result from the analysis of the survey.

**7. THE TABLES.** The items of goods have been grouped as follows and tables on the most important items in each group published:

(i) Inter-Regional Movement:

- All items—1
- Food crops—2
- Cash crops—3
- Manufactured Food and Drinks—4
- Other Manufactured goods—5
- Miscellaneous goods—6

(ii) Inter-Divisional Movement:

- All items—7
- Food crops—8
- Cash Crops—9
- Manufactured Food and Drinks—10
- Other manufactured goods—11
- Miscellaneous goods—12

**8.1 RELIABILITY OF THE DATA PUBLISHED.** The reliability of these data is a little difficult to measure. But users will do well to take the following points into careful consideration while using the estimates.

**8.2** Firstly, for these data to be sufficiently reliable, this sort of survey must be conducted more frequently than once in a year taking into consideration possible seasonal fluctuation in the movement of items between places. For lack of funds and the fact that the result of the first survey was not analysed early enough, it was not possible to repeat the survey again since the last one. It is hoped that this difficulty should be removed in future.

**8.3** Figures relating to movement of goods from Western Nigeria to the other regions and vice versa, as far as the dates covered are concerned and bearing in mind the points raised in paragraphs 9 to 10.2 above, can be said to be very reliable because of its complete coverage. This is because the selection of census points was so carefully done that all known contact points between Western Nigeria and the other regions were covered. The same cannot however be said for the intra-regional figures due to the fact that the census points did not cover the entire divisional/town contact points in the region. For instance, there were no census points between Oyo and Ibadan, Iwo and Ibadan, Abeokuta and Ibadan, Ilesha and Oshogbo, Akure and Owo, Akure and Ilesha, Ilesha and Ife, Ibadan and Ife, etc. It was not possible to increase the census points as the available fund for the survey was strictly limited. Infact, we were able to cover so many census points only because four different organisations (*see* paragraph 1 above) agreed to pool their resources together.

**8.4** There is one remote but possible source of inflation in the analysed results which may be due to the possible existence of double counting. Double counting could occur not only from the possibility of counting a vehicle and its contents at two or more census points but also from the fact that the same goods can, by sheer process of movement, be erroneously made to originate from two or more different places. For instance, a trader may bring say cloths from Lagos to Ibadan. If the cloths were intercepted at Ikorodu, their origin would be given as Lagos. The same cloths, probably failing to attract good prices at Ibadan or after being sold to another trader may be carried in another vehicle to another place whereby the same cloths' origin, on being intercepted by another group of enumerators elsewhere, would be given as Ibadan. The result, of course, is that the same quantity of cloth, or part of it, has been counted twice leading to inflated figures. It is possible that in this analysis, such subtle element of double counting is present, but for lack of information, its extent or degree is indeterminable.

**8.5** Inter-regional trade as used in this context, refers only to movement of goods between Western Nigeria and the other regions of the Federation. As noted in paragraph 10.3 above the survey from which the analysis is derived, provided full coverage for the movement of goods between the Western region and the other regions because we were able to identify all the points where the West could make contacts with the other regions and enumerators were put at such points. But between any other two regions, a full coverage was not possible because contact points exist between Nigeria. For instance, one could get to the North from the East without necessarily passing through the West. It, therefore, follows that the tables hereby published cannot be taken as a good representative of movement of

goods between any two regions in Nigeria which exclude the West. Essentially, the figures, as far as other regions (i.e., excluding Western region) are concerned, relate to goods that passed from one region, through the West, to another.

**8.6** One can also pick bones with the method of derivation of the raising factors. Firstly, for the raising factors used for North-West and West-North movements (i.e., paragraphs 7.2 (i) and (ii) the returns used relate to movement by rail whereas the returns to which they were applied relate to road haulage. As it were, there has not been established any ratio based on sound and scientific inference, and measuring the degree of relationship, between road and rail haulage in the country. At best, we can only assume that road and rail haulage follow the same pattern in normal years. This is the assumption on which this calculation has been based. Secondly, and this is more serious, the railway returns related to a few items only whereas during the survey, all movable items were covered. When we take the aggregate items, we see that where both rail and road transport systems exist together, certain items could be more popular with one system than the other and vice versa. We have not taken this into consideration in our computation.
