

#### **External Links to Newspapers.com**



Since August 2014 when Wikipedia Library launched a partnership with newspapers.com, external links jumped from 1,198 to 3,975 (+ 330%, in blue). Linked open access 'clips' jumped from 358 to 1,856 (+520%, in red)
