گل‌محمد، پسر دوم خانواده که به‌تازگی از خدمت اجباری سربازی بازگشته و همسر نیز دارد، عاشق مارال می‌شود و او را به همسری می‌گیرد. این ازدواج تخم عدوت و محاصره را در دل دلاور، نامزد سابق مارال، می‌کارد. با گذشت داستان، تنش‌ها و کشمکش‌ها میان طایفه‌ها و خانواده‌های مختلف تشدید می‌شود و در میان این منازعات و دشمنی‌ها، گل‌محمد مردی را به قتل می‌رساند. پس از وقوع این حادثه، دو آمیبه به بهانه وصول مالیات گله‌هایی که وجود نداشت و در اصل برای تحقیق در رابطه با جنایت انجام‌گرفته به نزدیکی آن منطقه می‌آیند. گل‌محمد که به اصل ماجرا پی برده بود آمیبه‌ها را می‌کشد و جسدشان را می‌سوزاند. گل‌محمد دستگیر و زندانی می‌شود، اما سرانجام به کمک ستار از زندان می‌گریزد. ستار فعال سیاسی و عضو حزب توده است که در منطقه زیر پوشش یک بنه‌دوز به فعالیت سیاسی می‌پردازد و در رقابتهایش گل‌محمد را رهبر آینده و بالقوه قیام مردمی ایران می‌بیند. گل‌محمد پس از فرار به‌ناچار زندگی مخفانه‌ای را پیش می‌گیرد.<sup>[۸]</sup>

گل‌محمد و بارانش به جنگ با ارباب‌ها و خان‌ها که دهقانان فقیر و عشایر را مطیع خود کرده‌اند و از آنها سوءاستفاده می‌کنند می‌پردازند. افسانه‌ها برامون گل‌محمد و باران مسلح به سرعت در سرتاسر منطقه می‌پیچد و گل‌محمد که اندک‌اندک به چهره‌ای محبوب نزد مردم تبدیل می‌شود، در نقش قهرمان آنان ظاهر می‌شود. برای گل‌محمد دشواری‌ها تازه شروع شده‌است، دلشوره حفظ قهرمانی مشکل‌تر از قهرمان شدن است. فشارهای روانی گل‌محمد را غرق در تردید، سراسیمگی، سردگمی، و تشویش درونی می‌کند. گل‌محمد احساس می‌کند که به آخر خط رسیده و پایان کارش نزدیک است. با تلاش نافرجام یکی از اعضای حزب توده برای ترور **محمد رضا پهلوی**، آخرین شاه ایران، ورق بر می‌گردد. حزب توده به محاق سیاسی فرو می‌رود و از هرگونه فعالیت رسمی منع می‌شود. اوضاع سیاسی جامعه دستخوش تغییراتی بنیادین می‌شود و دهقانان رنج‌کشیده‌ای که روزی برای ایستادگی در برابر اربابان زورگو هم‌قسم شده بودند، یکی پس از دیگری شانه‌های می‌کنند. اربابان و مقامات حکومتی در نهایت موفق می‌شوند تا ناآرامی‌ها و شورش‌ها را بخوابانند و زمان کلیدر با کشته‌شدن گل‌محمد و تقریباً تمامی کسانی که به نحوی با خانواده کلمینشی مرتبط بودند به پایان می‌رسد. ستار نیز که برخلاف دستورالعمل‌های حزب توده هم‌بای گل‌محمد جنگیده بود، کشته می‌شود.<sup>[۹]</sup>

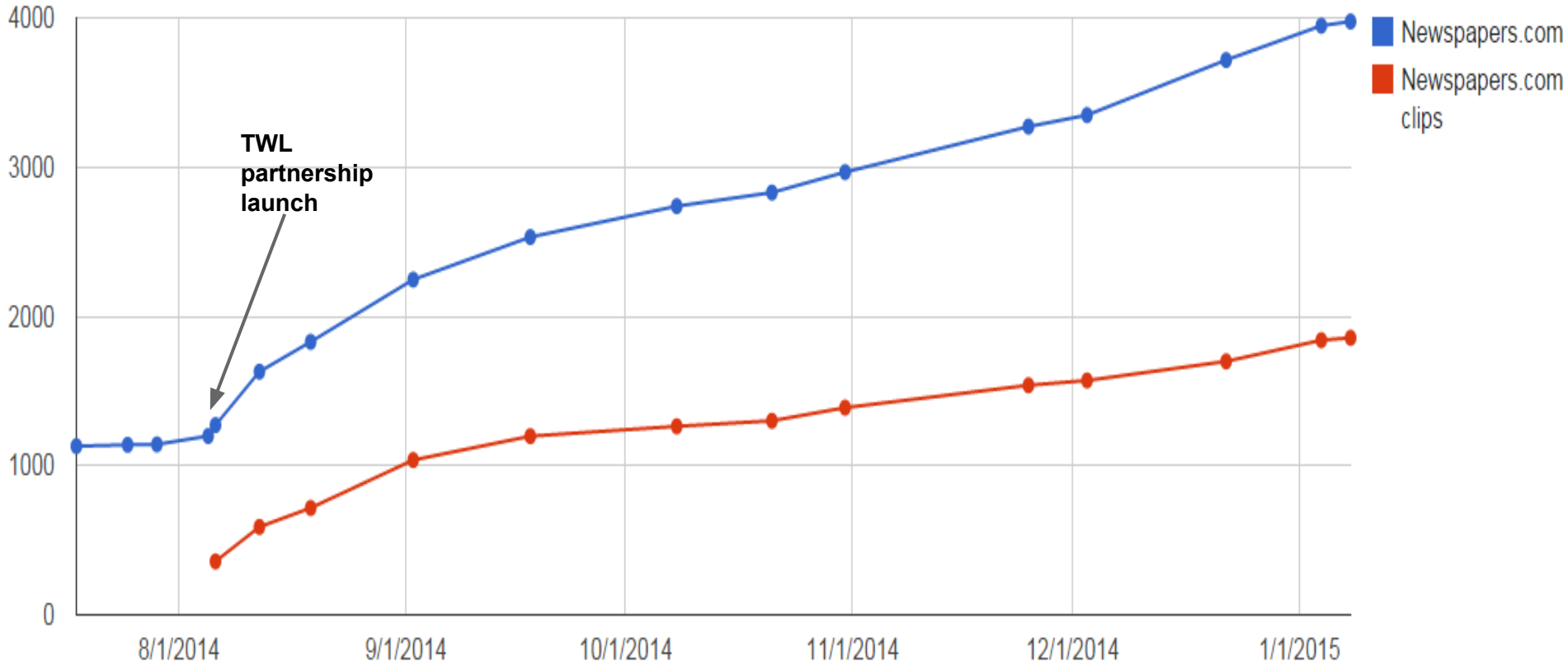

# External Links to Newspapers.com



Since August 2014 when Wikipedia Library launched a partnership with newspapers.com, external links jumped from 1,198 to 3,975 (+ 330%, in blue) . Linked open access 'clips' jumped from 358 to 1,856 (+520%, in red)
