#### Our Select Radish Seed Produces Sound, Firm Roots


The best radish seed comes from Brittany, in France, and is grown on land that has been reclaimed from the sea. This soil, with its sub-irrigation, produces sound, shap ly roots, and the se qualities are to a certain extent perpetuated in the seed. Radish seed from the south of France is grown very much more cheaply, but is undesirable and should not be used.
