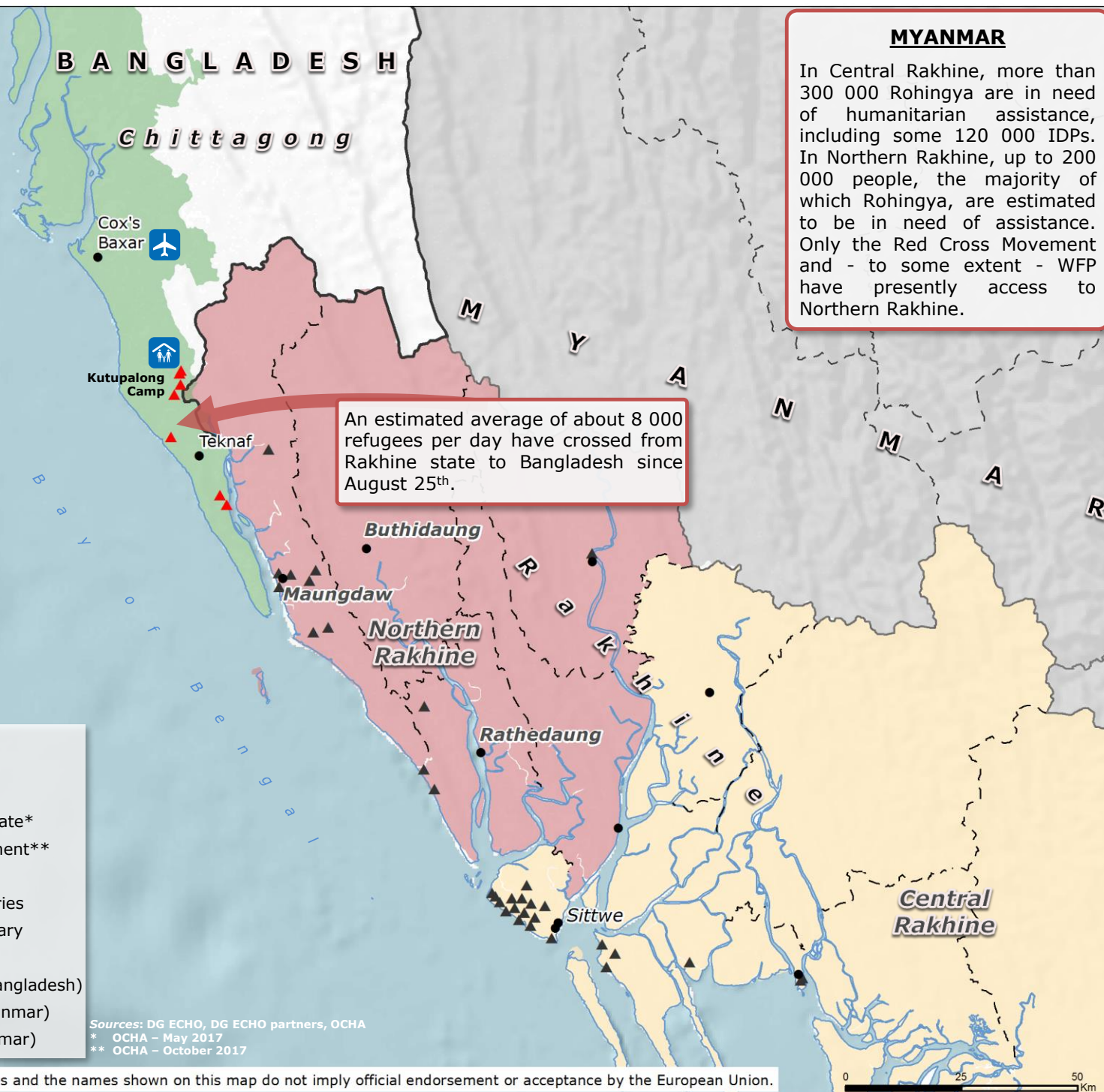


BANGLADESH

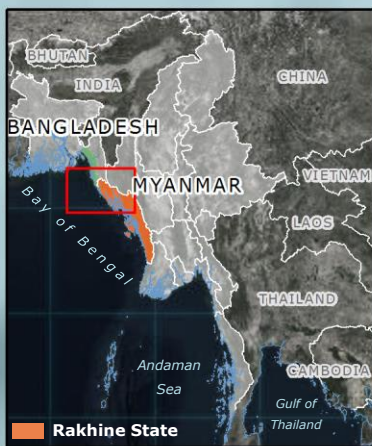
It is estimated that more than 830 000 people are presently in need of humanitarian assistance in Cox's Bazar, of which 55% are children. 618 000 new arrival since 25 August 2017 (338 000 in Kutupalong Expansion Site, 234 000 in other settlements and camps and 46 000 in host communities). Urgent needs in food assistance, nutrition, shelter, health, protection, water and sanitation. Serious risks of diseases outbreaks - including measles and cholera - and high number of SGBV reported.

MYANMAR

In Central Rakhine, more than 300 000 Rohingya are in need of humanitarian assistance, including some 120 000 IDPs. In Northern Rakhine, up to 200 000 people, the majority of which Rohingya, are estimated to be in need of assistance. Only the Red Cross Movement and - to some extent - WFP have presently access to Northern Rakhine.



An estimated average of about 8 000 refugees per day have crossed from Rakhine state to Bangladesh since August 25th.
