Hatches require to be cut in the stokehold for access to the bilge roses.

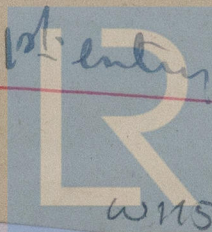
Nothing has been done here towards the electric lighting installation.
