1. Reference URAD KFX 00592 dated 20 December 1946 and KFX 00715 dated 2 January 1946 and Circular 325 Headquarters Eighth Army, dated 18 December 1946.

2. Petroleum requirements estimates for the month of August 1947 are as follows:

1. The cache of oil referred to in the basic communication was stored at the former Hayashi Flour Mill located at No. 1574 Ohtani, Sumiyoshi-kura, Muko-gun, Hyogo-ken. This cache of oil consisted of 3,500 5-gallon cans of C class machine oil.

2. On 13 May 1947 Wen Kaiwan, the chief of the Sannomiya Branch of International Times moved this oil from the warehouse and sold it to the Kobe Truck Company and other automobile companies at prices exceeding the ceiling price.

3. Wen Kaiwan told Yoshichigo En, the custodian of the warehouse that the oil belonged to him, and he had received permission from Hyogo Military Government and the Prefectural Government to dispose of it.

4. Because of the unauthorized removal of this oil and sale in violation of the price control, this case is being investigated by the police.

1. Further investigation of the cache of oil referred to in basic communication disclosed that of the amount of oil removed from the former Hayashi Flour Mill by Wen Kaiwan only 2,075 cans were salvageable due to corrosion.

2. Wen Kaiwan sold the oil to rubber factories, iron works and motor service stations at a total price of Yen 801,350.--, which is Yen 573,082 over the official price.

3. To acquire this property Wen told the custodian of the mill that he bought it from the owner of the mill for Yen 400,000.- in October 1945, presuming that there were 3,000 cans stored there.

4. In February 1947 Hayashi, owner of the mill, died, so Wen's statement cannot be corroborated.

5. As the investigation is completed Wen Kaiwan and fifteen (15) other suspects have been sent to the Procurator for violations of regulations governing control prices of commodities and allotment of designated materials.
