1. On 17 June 1949, Kyoto Liaison and Coordination Office advised as follows:

"1. HIJIKAWA, ex-junior procuratorial official and currently serving with the 22nd CID who played the leading role in starting the uncovering of the alleged Kyoto District Public Procurators' Office corruption, is slated for trial on July 6, starting from 13:00 hours, and with judge Yamazaki presiding, on the indictment dated 3 November 1948 for the suspected bribery.

2. The procurator to prosecute the case has not yet been decided.

3. KATO, Yuko, another junior procuratorial official involved in the subject case, was served on June 2 with a letter of dismissal dated 25 May. Defying the official order of transfer to Mineyama Branch of the KDPFO which had been previously issued to him. Kato has been staying in Kyoto working for the Court Authority, I Corps."

2. It is desired that a representative of the Kyoto Military Government Team be present at the trial as an observer to see that Hijikawa gets a fair trial.

3. Report arrangements made by Kyoto Military Government Team to comply with paragraph 2 above.
