WIKIPEDIA The Free Encyclopedia



- A website where anyone can edit any page at any time
- Meant to be "quick"
- Remembers all versions (nothing ever destroyed)
- Hyperlinks between pages

Wikipedia: Five Pillars

- Wikipedia is an encyclopedia
- Wikipedia is written from a neutral point of view
- Wikipedia is free content that anyone can use, edit, and distribute
- Wikipedia's editors should treat each other with respect and civility
- Wikipedia has no firm rules



Wikipedia Policies

- **Neutral Point of View** written so all sides can agree (WP:POV)
- **Notability** significant independent sources -> importance (WP:N)
- Verifiability Using reliable sources to reference information (WP:V)
- No original research point to existing scholarship (WP: NOR)
- Assume good faith start with congenial spirit (WP:GF)
- **Conflicts of interest** disclose and abide by terms of service (WP:COI)

Wikipedia: Reliable sources

Articles should be based on reliable, published sources. If no reliable sources can be found on a topic, an article should not exist.

Reliable sources per WP guidelines

- Published scholarship (print or online)
- News organizations
- Vendor and e-commerce sources (Can be used to verify awards won, album length, etc.)
- Biased or opinionated sources (Only when trying to report the existence of one side of a topic, debate, etc.)

Unreliable sources

- Questionable sources. (Those with a poor reputation for checking the facts or with no editorial oversight)
- Self-published sources including websites*
- Primary sources*
- Social media sites including Linkedin

* These can be added to external links section, but should not be cited

Challenges: Article Editing and Creation

Barriers to article creation include:

- Lack of access to editing training
- Fewer secondary sources due to limited coverage of women's accomplishments
- Absence of freely-licensed images

Solutions include:

- Increasing outreach to new editors through workshops and edit-a-thons
- Publishing verifiable information about women from all eras

Early career

Rielsen served during the George W. Bush administration as special assistant to the president and as senior director for prevention, preparedness and response (PPR) at the White House Homeland Security Council. She also set up, and led as assistant administrator, the Transportation Security Administration's Office of Legislative Policy and Government Affairs.


After leaving the Bush administration in 2008, Nielsen became the founder and president of Sunesis Consulting.^[6] The firm's online profile listed her as its only employee, with the firm's phone number being Nielsen's personal cellphone.^[7] In September 2013 the company won a federal contract, with an initial award of about \$450,000, to "provide policy and legislation, technical writing, and organizational development" to the Federal Emergency Management Agency.^[8]

Nielsen was a senior member of the Resilience Task Force of the Center for Cyber & Homeland Security Committee at George Washington University and served on the Global Risks Report Advisory Board of the World Economic Forum.^[4]

- **1.** Reserve the article using the Google sheet
- 2. Select your article red link from the event page to start a draft
- 3. Select 'Create' (top right)
- 4. Explore secondary sources (links)
- 5. Begin writing, add citations, hyperlinks, etc. Be sure to include section with 'references' header
- 6. Publish

*Don't hesitate to publish a 'stub' or short article, even if it only consists of a lead paragraph and references section

Creating Articles

To create articles when not participating in an editing event:

-type the article's name into the Wikipedia search bar. -When no result is produced, select the red link next to 'You may create this page'.

To start a draft:

-type the 'Draft:' and the article's name into the Wikipedia search bar. -When no result is produced, select the red link next to 'You may create this page'.

To write an article in Sandbox

-Login, select Sandbox -When done, move the page to Wikipedia main space


