EL 1-5757, was in some way connected with Bon Ami. on 8/13/63, telephonically contacted Mr. WEESNER
at the New York number. He was advised that JOSEPH MEROLA had been given the money to pay for the repairs on the two boats. WEESNER said that he would contact MEROLA and would then within a week contact and assure him that he would be paid for his work.
On 8/16/63, MEROLA came to the Charles Taylor Marine and told that Mr. WEESNER had told him of call.; MEROLA was disturbed because had contacted WEESNER to get his money.

A check of the Miami indices revealed WEESNER to be ROSCOE PAUL WEESNER, one of the subjects of a Registration Act - Haiti investigation (Bureau file 105-65978), (Miami file 105-1633). A review of this file revealed that WILLIAM KENNEY, Departmental Attorney, Miami, advised on 2/18/63 that he had received information from JOSEPH MEROLA that PAUL WEISSNER (PH), since identified as ROSCOE PAUL WEESNER, had approached MEROLA and solicited his assistance in a plan to overthrow the government of Haiti.

The above information concerning MEROLA's activities has been submitted to the Bureau for the express purpose of incorporating this information in MEROLA's file containing the investigation of his anti-racketeering activities.
