

SITUATION

- A **5.8M** earthquake at a depth of 19.4km hit SW Uzbekistan, ca. 40km NE of Samarqand on **26 May** at 06h08 UTC. USGS indicates shaking of up to "Very Strong" for ca. 25,000 people. As of early on 27 May there were no reports of serious damage or casualties.
- One day earlier, on **25 May**, another earthquake of magnitude **5.5M** at a depth of 9km hit 41km south of the capital Tashkent, causing slight damage and some power outages in the epicentre area, as well as in Tashkent itself. This earthquake exposed another 24,000 people to "Very Strong" shaking.
