
26 November 2014: West Africa - Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) Outbreak

SITUATION

- The transmission of the EVD continues in the four West African countries, with over 1 000 cases reported between 11 and 16 November. All administrative divisions in Liberia and Sierra Leone have reported at least one case since the beginning of the epidemic. However, case reporting remains problematic and attacks on health workers and Ebola awareness teams are not uncommon.
- The health systems of Guinea, Sierra Leone and Liberia have collapsed due to the uncontained EVD outbreak, rendering it impossible to treat other patients effectively. Furthermore, the food security situation is worsening and displacement of people for fear of contracting the disease occurs despite the imposed quarantines.
- The European Union is using all available resources to help fight the epidemic, including deploying humanitarian experts in the region and mobilising medical evacuation capacities for humanitarian workers.
