G.H.Q. 24th Object: Members of Herbor Workers Union and unorganized herbor workers. Method: Conference with several representatives of the representative harbor unions and unorganize workers, for about 3 hours. 2. He makes lecture for rank and file members and unorganized workers in as large number as possible and enswer their questions. 3. Conference with Several Representative Employers. Reference: (1) The Labor Department of the Prefecture concerned shall decide the Time end Place of the Meeting and how many number of the workers end what kind of workers are called and notice to the Labor Ministry (Labor Education Section) about it. It is necessary that the lecture should be held at most proper time so that as many as workers can attend. So it may be the time during from the evening to night. Conference with the employer may be held concurrently with the conference with the union officials. (2) Movies will be shown at the meeting, so the Labor Dept. shall prepare the proper films (1 or 2 reels) and projector. "Grievance Machinery" film (3 reels - 35 mm) shell be offered by the Labor Ministry.

- (3) An interpreter will go with Mr. Warren from L.P. G.H.Q., however it is desirable that the Labor Dept. will prepare one more.
- (4) On conducting this program the Labor Dept. of the Prefecture shall closely connect with the trade union and other agencies (such as Sea Transportation Board etc.) in advance and ask their ocoperation.

The Labor Ministry will make lisison with the National Union and ask the cooperations. Labor Divisions G.H.Q. will connect with the Kanto Region C.A.T. in advance.

- (5) Expenses necessary for conducting this program shall be managed by the Labor Dept. of the Prefecture.
- (6) As Mr. Warren is now being in field trip, there may be some changes in this programme.
