


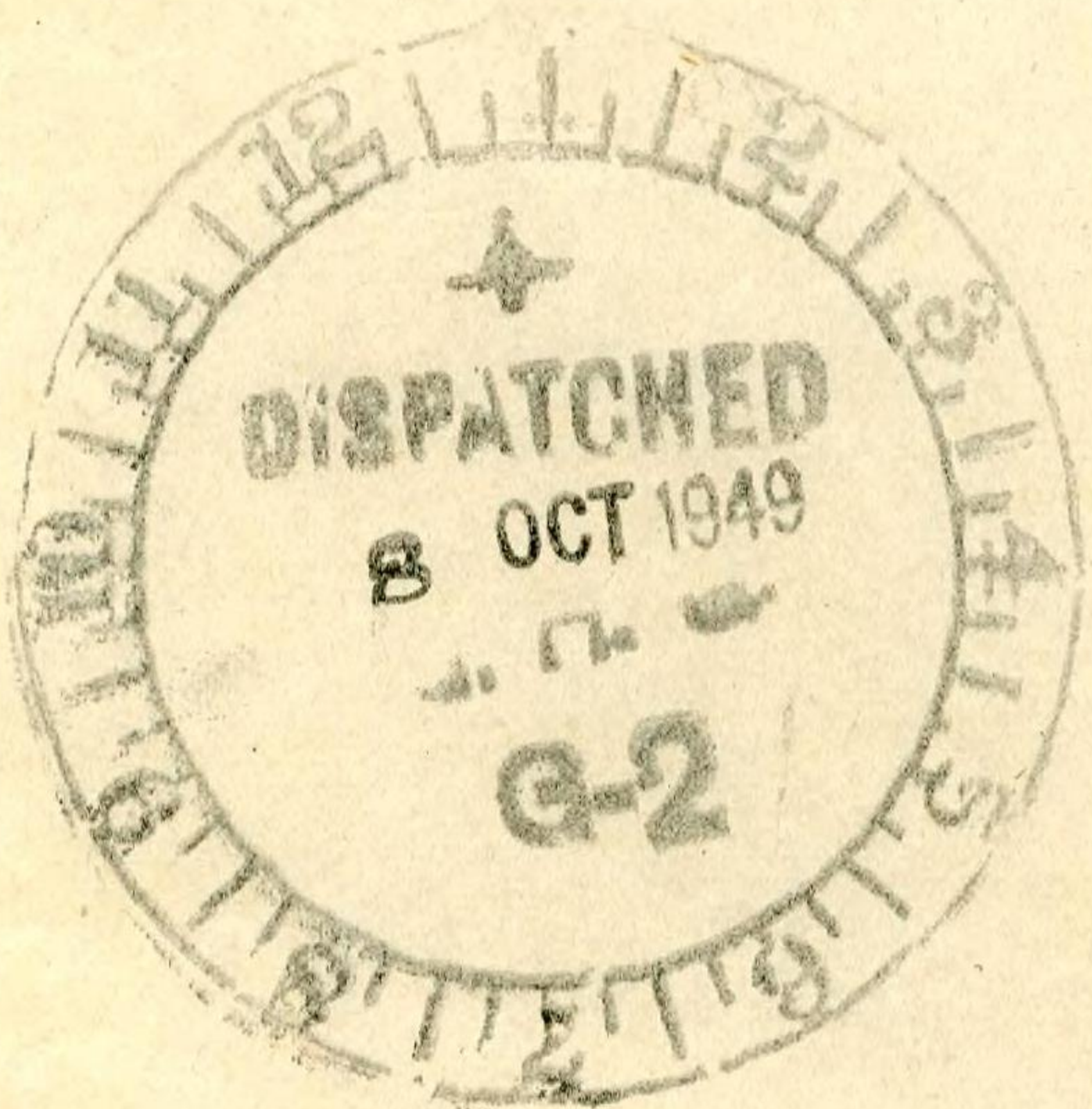

1. Forwarded herewith one (1) copy Korea Liaison Office Report #44, subject "Propaganda Leaflet Dropped at PAKKCHON (930-1690)," dated 21 July 1949. This report is the translation of a leaflet printed in Chinese and Korean characters dropped by a North Korean aircraft at 1255 hours, 10 July 1949.

2. The leaflet is addressed to all Korean democratic political parties and social bodies and to all the Korean people. It states that American imperialists are interfering with the unification of all Korea, and that it is the American imperialists who are insulting the Koreans as a race too illiterate to administer and develop their own country.

3. The leaflet goes on to say that Syngman RHEE and his conspirators under the protection of the U.S. Military authorities have created the "National Assembly" for the sole purpose of legalizing and justifying treacherous acts in written laws and that S Syngman RHEE has been executing and jailing those Koreans who oppose him.
