Remarkably fine plants and masses of Angræcums, Dendrobiums, Saccolabiums, *Ærides*, etc., are offered.

From our bright sun and clear bright atmosphere my Tropical Orchids are superior to any grown in England, or the continent of Europe. My Dendrobiums make longer, thicker and finer Pseudo-Bulbs than they have when received from their native countries. *Ærides*, Saccolabiums, Vandas, Phalanopsis, etc., make stronger growths, with rampant roots and healthy foliage. Our climate is perfection for Tropical Orchids.

My prices are very much lower than they can be purchased for in Europe, in many cases not more than one-half, and stronger, and in every respect superior plants. A few scarce species are not priced; the same will be given on application.

It is difficult to give prices of Orchids in a catalogue; a plant of any species may not be worth one dollar, whilst a fine plant of the same species may be worth five dollars. Orchids, I can supply cheap and nice plants; I have also fine specimens, when such are desired, at extra prices. Of many I can supply large masses. Parties forming collections would do well to visit my establishment, and look out their plants. I have every confidence they will be more than pleased in quality and price. All are established in Pots or Baskets, or upon Blocks.

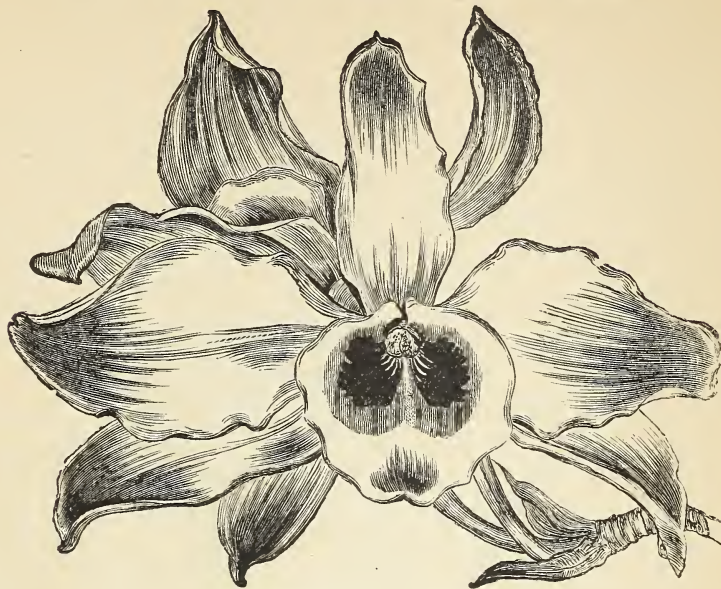
