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Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance

The pillbox is located along the western boundary of Matapang Beach 9.0 m from the high tide line. Built of steel-reinforced concrete mixed with coral and beach rubble, the structure is in excellent condition. It appears to be in its original position.

While the overall dimensions are 4.0 m by 2.70 m, the pillbox has a complex configuration. It has six exterior walls. Sand is banked against the exterior of the south or inland wall which is .25 m to .30 m thick. A small air vent is located in the south wall. The west wall, about .45 m thick, has a gun port with a view of the center portion of Tumon Bay. The northeast wall, .50 m thick, has a gun port with a view of the northeast portion of Tumon Bay. The entrance and an air vent are located in the east wall.

An interior wall divides the space into two rooms, each having an embrasure. The interior height of the structure from the present sand floor to the ceiling is 1.35 m. Horizontal impressions of the boards used to build the form into which the concrete was poured are apparent on the exterior and interior walls.

The roof slab of the structure is about .25 m thick. To this a conglomerate of concrete, coral, and glass fragments measuring about .15 m to .20 m thick has been added to the exterior surface of the roof. This conglomerate is heaped higher in the center than at the edges of the roof. Over the entrance to the structure, the roof has been reinforced with a cement strip, .20 m wide, .05 m to .20 m high, and 1.50 m long. Impressions of tabi prints and a possible Japanese character are apparent in the cement of the roof. The exterior height of the structure is 1.45 m above ground surface.

Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)

The West Matapang pillbox was constructed during the Japanese occupation of Guam, a period of time extending from December 1941 through July 1944. Although the exact date of its construction is unknown, it may have been built in the spring of 1944. One of the two Japanese military units assigned to Tumon Bay, the 48th Independent Mixed Brigade or part of the 29th Division, may have been in charge of its construction which probably also involved a work force made up of Guamanian males.

Tumon Bay was among the most extensively fortified beaches on the west coast. Therefore this structure was part of a complex defensive system which extended from Bijia Point in the north to Ypao Point in the south. This structure is significant because its unique shape illustrates the variety of free-standing pillboxes located along the coastline of Guam. It also provides information about the spatial distribution of defensive positions in the system designed by the Japanese to defend the coastline of Guam.


