


# Our workflow



## Romulea flava

**Romulea flava**, also known by its common name Greenback fritillary, is a species of flowering plant from the genus *Romulea*.<sup>[1]</sup> The plant is native to the Cape Province and has been introduced into Australian states of New South Wales, Victoria and Western Australia.<sup>[2]</sup> It grows to a height of 10 to 15cm and has flowers that are white or yellow on the outside with an inner yellow cup.<sup>[3]</sup> The flowers only open on days that are warm and sunny and usually only in the afternoon.<sup>[3]</sup> It has four accepted infraspecifics:<sup>[3]</sup>

- *Romulea flava* var. *flava*
- *Romulea flava* var. *minor* (Berg) M.Pde Vos
- *Romulea flava* var. *strumosa* (Berg) M.Pde Vos
- *Romulea flava* var. *viridiflora* (Berg) M.Pde Vos


