

Instructions for Ordering.




Please use enclosed Order Sheet. You will find it a convenience; it will facilitate my work, and may also prevent errors.

Strong, healthy young plants of Chrysanthemums will be ready for delivery during March, April, May and June, 1897. I commence to ship plants for early delivery March 1, and orders may be sent at any time, and the plants will be forwarded at once; or, if customers desire it, the order can be held and plants sent later in the season.

 If choice of varieties is left to me, and customers will state what they desire, I will select according to my experience and best judgment.

HOW TO HAVE PLANTS SENT.

If small lots of plants are sent to distant points, the best means of shipment is by mail, as it is cheaper than by express, and I *prepay all mail packages* without extra charge. I desire to call particular attention to my careful system of packing plants for the mails, by which I am enabled to have plants arrive at their destination in perfect condition. The plants are securely packed in a mailing box made especially for the purpose, which prevents their being crushed in the mails, and they can be safely sent to any part of the United States in perfect order. Last season I sent plants by mail as far west as Oregon and California, and they were received in perfect condition. In large lots and to near-by points, the best means of shipment is by express, and I generally put in enough "extra" plants to balance the express charges. My responsibility ceases after plants have been carefully packed and delivered to forwarder.

 Orders from unknown correspondents must be accompanied by cash or satisfactory references.

DIRECTIONS FOR SOWING.

Sow in shallow boxes of light soil early in spring, and place in a light window or greenhouse, in a temperature of about 65°. Cover the seed lightly with light soil, and water with a fine spray. When the seedlings are an inch high, transplant them into similar boxes or 2-inch pots, and plant out in the garden after danger from frost is past.
