"An Outline of the Central Political Conference"

Nanking, Mar. 19, 1940.

1. In conformity with the resolution made at the general assembly of the representatives of the Chinese National Party, President Wang convoked a meeting of the representatives of the existing government and legitimate opposition parties, and distinguished men of social standing for the organization of a Central Administrative Assembly, with the hope of abolishing one-party autocracy and effecting a collaboration of the various parties and groups.
2. The people who shall participate in the Central Administrative Assembly as the representatives of the existing government and legitimate opposition parties shall be decided upon consultation between Wang and the leaders of each of these bodies. The distinguished men of social standing shall be invited by Wang.
