3. The 8076th Mobile Army Surgical Hospital is the only one presently operating at full T/O & E strength. Experience in the past few months' operation in Korea has proven that the efficiency of these units has been greatly retarded because of the inadequacy of the organization structure.

4. These units are currently performing missions above and beyond their normal capabilities due to the exigencies of the military situation and it is anticipated that the present condition will continue for some time. It is therefore highly desirable that these units have an organization that more nearly conforms to their mission.

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Reorganization of Bulk Authorization Medical Units

1. CG, Eighth Army, in letter AG 322 KGO to CINCFE, subj: as above, 17 Sep 50, requested the reorganization of three (3) bulk authorization Medical Units. The three (3) Medical units concerned are:

- a. 8055th (aggregate strength: 118) Mobile Surgical Hosp
- b. 8063rd (aggregate strength: 118) Mobile Surgical Hosp
- c. 8076th (aggregate strength: 126) Mobile Surgical Hosp.

Eighth Army proposes to reorganize the three (3) hospitals under T/O&E 8-571, with the aggregate strength of 156 each. CG, Eighth Army, considers that the above units have been performing missions above those normally assigned to such units due to the military situation. It is felt that the efficiency of these units has been retarded because of the inadequacy of the organizational structure.

2. Medical Section in C/N 1 to G-4 and G-3, 5 Oct 50, concurred in Eighth Army request. Medical Section also stated that the three (3) mobile Surgical Hospitals have been providing support to four (4) Divisions, plus miscellaneous brigades, regiments, etc. Normal assignment of a Mobile Surgical Hospital is one (1) per Division.

3. ^{been}CG, Eighth Army, has stated that the efficiency of the Medical Units has/retarded because of the present organizational structure and feels that additional personnel are necessary in view of past experiences. The Surgeon, GHQ, has also agreed that the Mobile Surgical Hospitals should have a personnel increase. It is felt that in order to accomplish the requested reorganization that authority should be obtained from the DA to organize as T/O&E units instead of increasing the bulk authorization.

4. If this request is approved, it will increase Medical strengths on hand and requisitioned from the DA from 20,289 to 20,395 as compared to a Medical slice of 22,093.

5. Recommend approval of C/N 2 which recommends to G-3 that authority be obtained to reorganize subject units under the applicable T/O&E.

6. Within established policy.

7. Completes action on G-4 Journal No. 14233.

1. Upon displacement of EUSAK Headquarters from its present area in TAEGU, now estimated to be completed on or about 15 October 1950, it is proposed to establish at this site a facility to be known as the United Nations Reception Center. The organization and operation of this facility will be the responsibility of the CG 2nd Logistical Command.

2. The mission to be assigned to the United Nations Reception Center is to clothe, equip and provide familiarization training with US Arms and equipment to UN troops as determined essential for operations in KOREA by the Reception Center Commander. It is now estimated that the maximum of troops to be trained during a given period will not exceed 6,200.

3. In accordance with the above, it is desired that the Commanding General, 2nd Logistical Command:

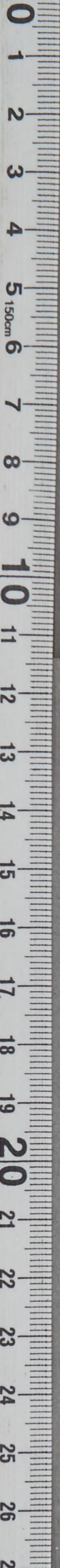
- a. Take the necessary action to reserve the current site of EUSAK (Main) at TAEGU (TAEGU University) for the United Nations Reception Center.
- b. Organize and fill the United Nations Reception Center in accordance with the Table of Distribution and Table of Equipment to be provided under separate cover.

7 1. G-4 concurs in the need for reorganization of the Medical Units as requested by JLCOM.

2. The assignments of Medical personnel arriving through the FEC Replacement Stream are controlled by the Surgeon's Office, GHQ. Additional information obtained from the Medical Section (Major Archer) on 14 Sep 50 by G-4 (Major Tilton) was that the portion of Medical personnel that must come from the Replacement Stream to effect the proposed reorganization will be controlled so as not to deprave Korea of needed Medical specialists. In reality, the units listed in Inclosure 1 to the basic letter have already expanded in order to provide medical care for casualties from Korea. This was based on necessity rather than authority.

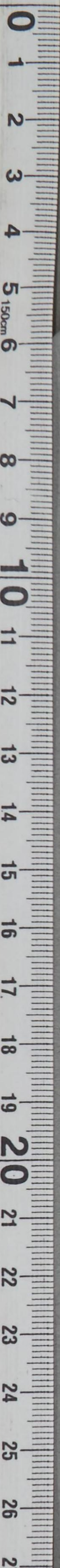

Due to the increased work-load imposed upon hospital facilities in Japan as a result of the military action in Korea, hospital facilities have been expanded approximately 50 per cent to meet the increased demand. The patient load has increased from 1529 as of 4 July 1950 to 9300 as of 23 September 1950.

2. The expansions thus far accomplished have been in the nature of added beds and consideration must be given to the allocation of additional spaces in order that the units listed in Inclosure #1, basic communication, can be properly staffed. Existing T/O&E dictates the spaces, and, also, is a basis for requisitioning supplies. The present T/O&E's are inadequate to meet the needs demanded.

3. Reference C/N, G-4 to Medical Section, GHQ, dated 14 September 1950, the Chief of Staff approved for the present a total of 18,000 fixed beds, which included the 8100 now in operation. Funds have been allocated for the rehabilitation of buildings being used by these hospital installations as a result of required expansions to meet demands.

4. Urgent need exists for personnel to meet the increased demands imposed on hospital facilities. In order to provide the required personnel to staff these units spaces must exist in the T/O&E; therefore the existing T/O&E's must be revised, a T/D Unit authorized the existing unit, or a bulk authorization to include additional personnel in all units listed in Inclosure #1, basic communication, be authorized.

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Reorganization of Medical Units

1. JLCOM ltr, AGNO 322, subj as above, 9 Sep 50, to CINCFE, requested that reorganization of six (6) Hospitals in the Yokohama Medical Depot be initiated. JLCOM felt that such reorganization would provide authority for requesting additional personnel and equipment to carry the increased load now being carried by the Hospitals in the Depot. It would also bring T/O&E and TD beds of the individual hospitals in closer relationship to actual operating beds. JLCOM stated that equipment and personnel would be obtained through sources available to JLCOM. Attached as Incl 1 was a brief resume of the number of additional Medical personnel involved. It calls for an increase of 536 persons above the present strength. The Medical Section C/N 1 indicated concurrence in the proposed expansion. G-4 in C/N 2 indicated their concurrence on 15 Sep 50 (G-4 JN 12336). G-3 in C/N 3 forwarded the correspondence to G-1 for comment.

2. G-1 in C/N 4 to G-3 on 21 Sep 50 interposed no objection to the proposed reorganization from the viewpoint of organization. G-1, however, felt that the request was premature from a personnel viewpoint. This was based on G-1 statement that Medical units in Korea are under-strength and should be brought to authorized strength first. G-3 in C/N 5 forwarded the correspondence to Medical Section and G-4 for further comment.

3. Medical Section in C/N 6 to G-3, thru G-4, on 5 Oct 50, stated that hospital facilities in the FEC have been expanded 50%. This expansion has been accomplished by adding beds to current units. This, however, does not provide the proper staff nor supplies. The CofS on 13 Sep 50 approved a total of 18,000 fixed beds for the FEC, including the 8100 now in operation.
Japan and Korea

4. It is felt that there is an urgent demand for personnel to meet the expanded hospital facilities. In reality, the hospitals have actually been operating with expanded facilities as dictated by necessity. They have been unable, however, to extend proper Medical treatment because of the limited personnel. Medical Section (Major Archer) states that the Surgeon's Office controls the assignment of Medical replacements arriving in the FEC and that if the reorganization is approved, Korea will not be deprived of needed Medical Specialists. It is felt that G-4 should concur in the proposed reorganization but that G-3 should decide how it should be accomplished.

5. Recommend approval of C/N 7 which indicates G-4 concurrence in the proposed reorganization.

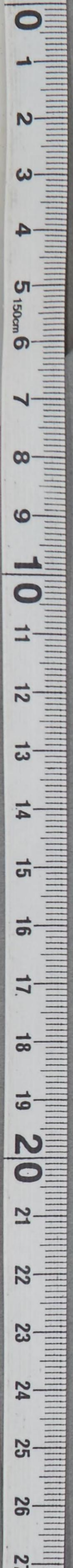

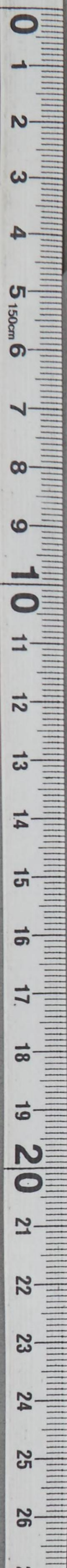

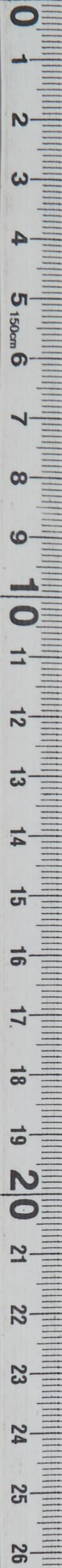

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD:

1. QM in C/N 1 to G-3 through G-4 and G-1 on 30 Sep 50 requested authority to reorganize 10 QM units now operating on R/T in accordance with applicable T/O&E. All QM units are in the FEC at the present time. QM stated that in determining the QM support necessary in current and projected operations, QM units were considered at full T/O&E strength and equipment.

2. The QM units listed in C/N 1 are units which CINCFE requested and were furnished from the ZI for the Korean emergency. CINCFE requested these units at T/O&E strength but they were shipped at R/T strengths. By placing the units on full T/O&E basis, the QM has a basis to request additional personnel from the ZI and can fill QM units, based on their needs, from the percentage afforded the QM from the replacement stream. In conversation with G-4 (Major Tilton) on 6 Oct 50, QM (Lt Col Frampton) stated that the requested increase was based on operational necessity. In considering the over-all QM units necessary to support operations, within the QM slice, QM units were considered at T/O&E strength.

3. Recommend approval of C/N 2 which informs G-3 through G-1 that G-4 concurs in the QM's recommendations.

4. If this request is approved, it will increase QM's strength on hand and requisitioned from the DA from 16,547 to 17,030 as compared to QM slice of 18,296.

SUBJECT: Medical Dispensary for Pusan Area

1. On 30 Sep 50, CG 8th Army, in Msg G-25230 KMD, to CINCFE, requested authority to organize from bulk authorization one (1) Dispensary Team, Column MC, T/O&E 8-500. CG, Eighth Army, also requested that if troop spaces were not available for the bulk authorization, that the 59th Med Dispensary in Yokohama be transferred to Eighth Army in Korea.
2. G-3 in C/N 1 to Surgeon and G-4 on 3 October 50 requested comments and recommendations on CG Eighth Army message. G-3 suggested that the 12th Medical Dispensary, less personnel and equipment, now in MARBO was available if desired. The Medical Section in C/N 2, through G-4 to G-3, 5 Oct 50, stated that the 59th Med Dispensary in Yokohama could not be released, and that the 12th Med Dispensary in MARBO was still required in MARBO. Medical Sec recommended that authority be granted to organize a Medical Dispensary, T/O&E 8-500, Column MC, with a strength of 17. If authority is granted to activate the Dispensary (MC), the Medical Section requests that one (1) General Dispensary (MA) requisitioned in CINCFE Msg CX 59543 be cancelled.
3. A check of the records shows that the Medical Section is in error in stating that the 12th Medical Dispensary is included in the MARBO troop list. MARBO Troop Unit Request No. 23 on 7 Aug 50 listed the 12th Med Dispensary as a unit to be inactivated. CINCFE Msg C 62598 to MARBO, 9 Sep 50, stated that units recommended for inactivation would be transferred, less personnel and equipment, to JLCOM. MARBO General Order No. 43, 3 Oct 50, transferred the 12th Med Dispensary, less personnel and equipment, to JLCOM as directed. It is not carried on MARBO Troop List submitted to the DA under CINCFE letter AG 320.2 (1 Oct 50)GC-TC, 1 Oct 50.
4. Whereas a unit of the type requested by Eighth Army is available to JLCOM, it is felt that that unit, the 12th Med Dispensary, should be used. JLCOM has not expressed any other use for the 12th Med Dispensary.
5. If this request is approved, it will increase Med strength on hand and requisitioned from the DA from 20,263 to 20,289 as compared to the Medical slice of 22,093.
6. Recommend approval of C/N 3, which recommends that the 12th Med Dispensary be transferred to Eighth Army to fulfill their request for a Medical Dispensary in Pusan.

2. A total of 18,000 fixed beds has been authorized for the present for Japan and support of the Korean effort. This 18,000 bed level includes the 8100 fixed beds in operation at the present. Fixed hospital units capable of operating an additional 8000 beds have been requisitioned of Department of the Army by CINCPAC. By separate action provisions have been made for the rehabilitation, conversion and/or construction of medical facilities in your command to provide 16,000 fixed beds.

3. Should an increase in the number of fixed and field type medical units over and above those units on requisition be deemed necessary in the foreseeable future, immediate consideration will be given to the procurement of additional units.

Eighth Army considered that 28,720 fixed hospital beds would be required for Japan and Korea. In addition, Eighth Army stated that they would require mobile medical units to support approximately seven divisions and supporting combat and service troops of 2 Corps. Attached to the letter as inclosures were lists of additional mobile and fixed hospital units that Eighth Army desired.

2. Med Sec has prepared a 1st Ind to JLCOM stating that GHQ does not concur in the need for the 28,720 fixed beds requested. The indorsement informs CG JLCOM that a ceiling of 18,000 fixed beds has been authorized at the present for Japan and in support of the Korean emergency. The 1st Ind also informs CG JLCOM that provisions have been made for rehabilitation, conversion and construction of medical facilities to provide 16,000 fixed beds in Japan.

3. The policy as outlined by the Surgeon in the 1st Ind is based on the recommendations of G-4, as approved by the CofS on 13 Sep, which authorized a ceiling of 18,000 fixed beds for Japan and support of the Korean emergency. (For additional background see JN 12172).

Subject: Reorganization of the 8054th Evacuation Hospital.

1. CG 8th Army in msg G 25069 KMD, 26 Sep to CINCFE requested authority to discontinue the 8054th Evacuation Hospital presently operating over and above rated capacity. In lieu of the 8054th Evacuation Hospital, CG 8th Army proposes to organize from bulk authorization one General Hospital (1,000 bed). Personnel and equipment from the 8054th Evacuation Hospital will be used in the General Hospital with additional personnel and equipment to be requisitioned through normal channels.
2. Medical Section in C/N 1 to G-3 through G-4 on 3 Oct stated that the Surgeon did not consider it advisable at this time to establish a General Hospital in Korea. The Surgeon desires to restrict General Hospital type treatment to Japan pending clarification of future troop concentrations in Korea. In place of the General Hospital requested, the Medical Section recommended that the 8054th Evacuation Hospital be redesignated as a Station Hospital (500 beds).
3. The 8054th Evacuation Hospital is a bulk authorization unit with a capacity of 400 beds. By redesignating it as a Station Hospital, the bed capacity is increased utilizing the same personnel used in the Evacuation Hospital. The Station Hospital operating as a "fixed" bed unit can provide better and more complete medical service than an Evacuation Hospital. Medical Section (Major Archer) in conversation with G-4 (Major Tilton) on 5 Oct 50 stated that the 500 bed Station Hospital would apply against the 2,000 "fixed" beds allocated for Korea. If this request is approved, it will increase medical strength on hand and requisitioned from the DA from 19,668 to 19,727 as compared to a medical slice of 22,093.
4. Recommend approval of C/N 2 which indicates G-4's concurrence in the Medical Section's recommendation to redesignate the 8054th Evacuation Hospital as a Station Hospital (500 beds).
5. Within established policy.
6. Completes action on G-4 Journal Number 14034.
