MEMORANDUM FOR: Director General, Economic Stabilization Board

SUBJECT: Fourth Quarter Allocation of Cotton Yarn

1. Reference is Demand and Allocation Table of Cotton Yarn for Fourth Quarter (Jan-Mar 1951), FY 1950, prepared by Economic Stabilization Board.

2. The allocation of cotton yarn for the fourth quarter, January-March 1951, is approved with the following changes:

a. Rubber and Its Products is reduced from 8,400,000 pounds to 8,200,000 pounds;

b. Marine Products Industry is increased from 5,000,000 pounds to 6,000,000 pounds;

c. Daily Necessaries is reduced from 1,200,000 pounds to 1,000,000 pounds; and

d. Clothing is reduced from 18,600,000, pounds to 18,000,000 pounds.
