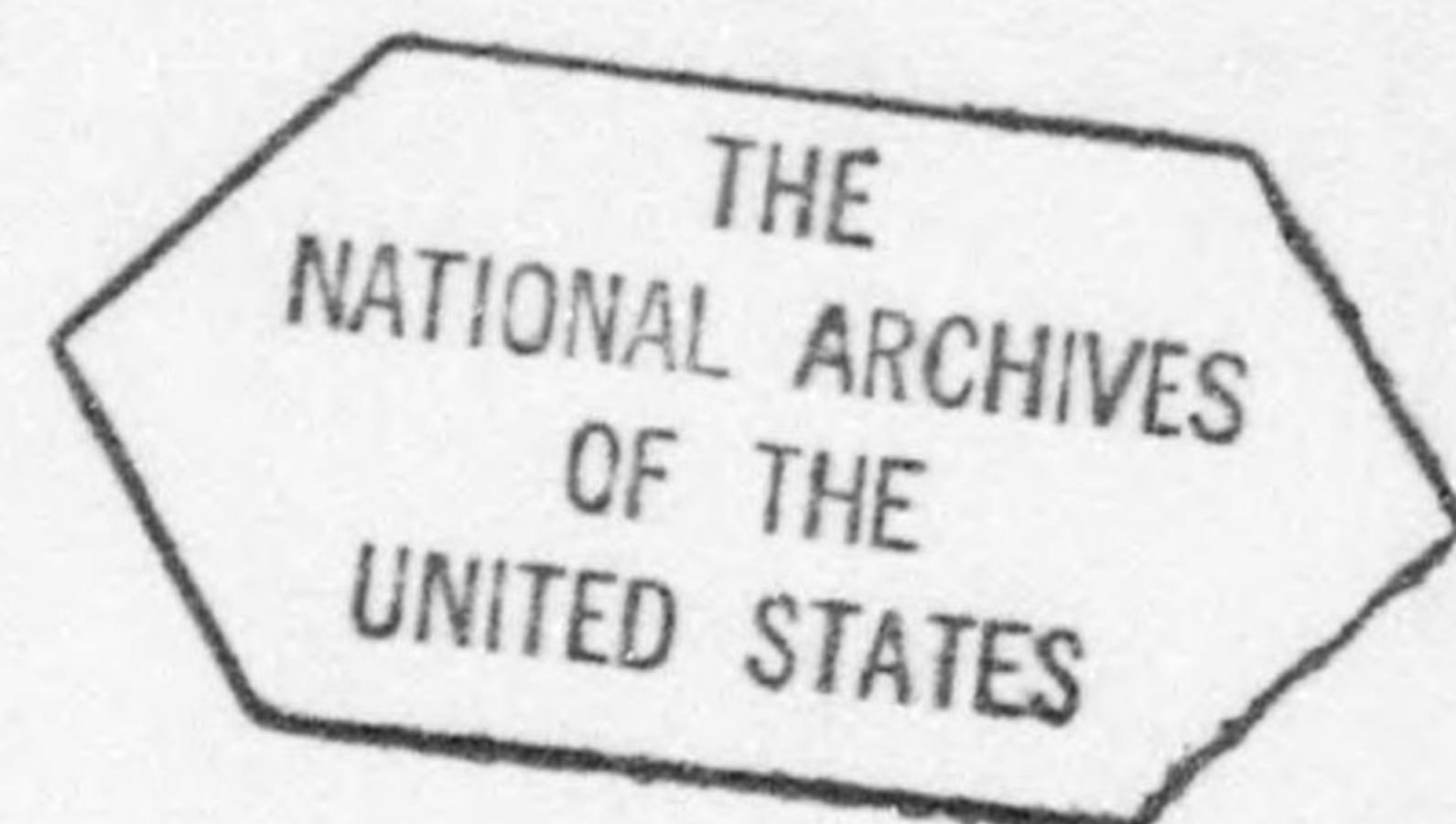

1. During the period 1 March - 30 April, 14,817 persons visited Hakone Park, a former Imperial Household property located in Kanagawa Prefecture and released to that prefectural government in November 1945.
2. Of that total, 9,682 were children, 5,135 were adults. These figures include 582 foreign nationals and members of the Occupation.
3. There are no admission fees or other charges collected from visitors to this Park.

2. Paragraph 3, Memorandum for Major Napier, subject: Imperial Household Property Converted to Public Parks was in error in that it contained the statement that admission was charged at Hakone Park. No admission is charged, and hence, there is no detailed report of the number of adults and children who visited the Park.

3. Hakone was a former Imperial Household property. It was released to the custody of the Governor of Kanagawa Prefecture on 3 November 1945 by the former Imperial Household Ministry. It became a prefectural park on 2 May 1946.
