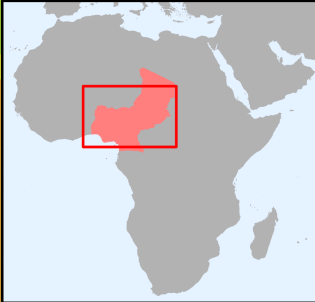


# Lake Chad complex crisis

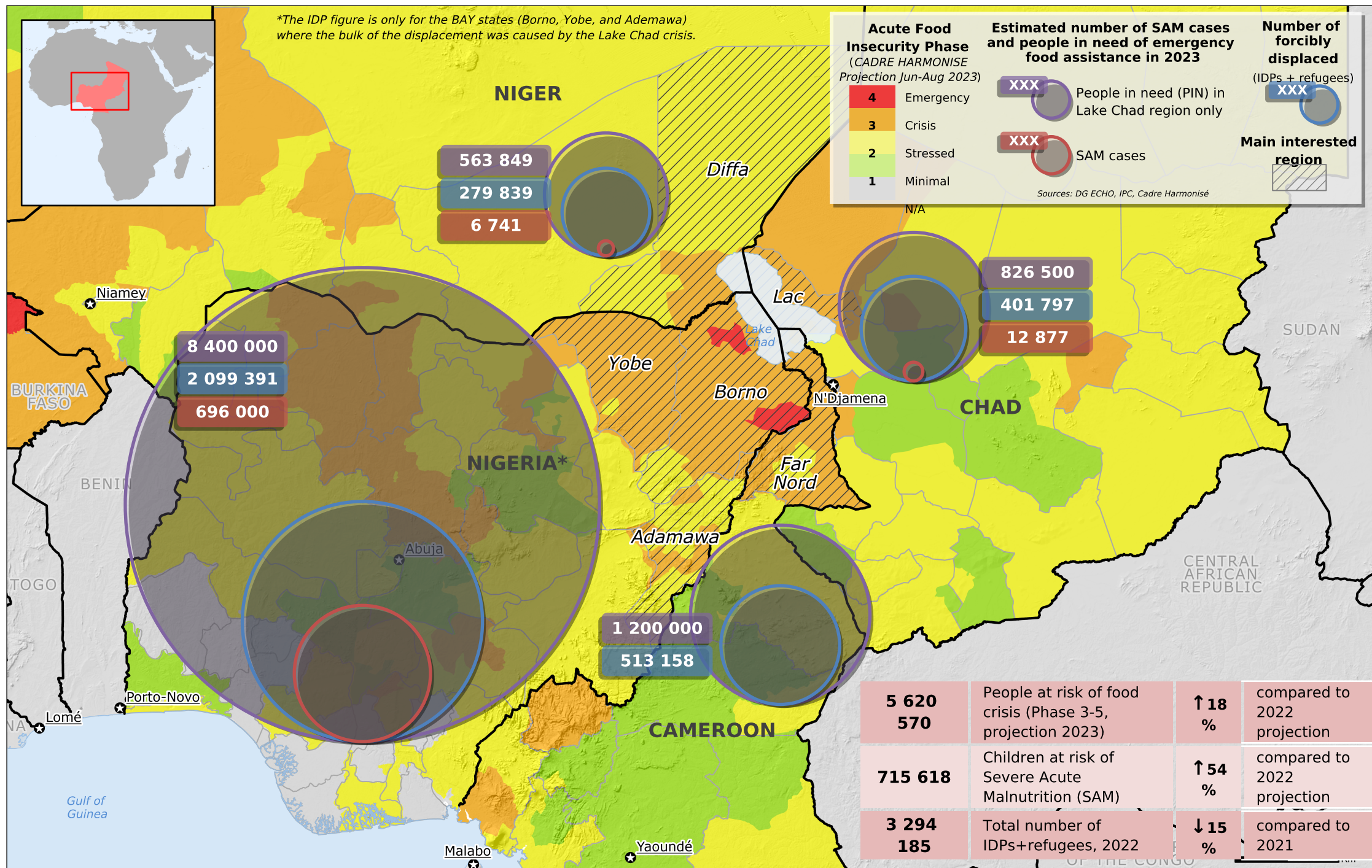
