BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Appropriation Short Title. Act 1862-3."

II. In order to provide means in advance of the receipts Treasury Bills authorised to limit of the Ordinary Revenue for defraying the authorised expenditure £35,000 to meet adof the General Government it shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer if thereunto authorised by an Order of the Governor in Council from time to time to borrow and take up money on the security of Treasury Bills carrying interest at a rate not exceeding six pounds per centum per annum and payable out of the Ordinary Revenue at the expiration of a time not exceeding twelve calendar months from the date thereof Provided that the total amount of principal money owing on the security of such Treasury Bills for the time being in circulation under this Act shall not in the aggregate at any time exceed thirty-five thousand pounds.

XXIII. If in the opinion of the Governor in Council the inter- Conditional ests of the Public Service would be promoted if the next Session of Appropriation Act for one year. the General Assembly were not held before the thirtieth day of June 1863 and if such Session be not held before that date there shall and may be issued and applied out of the Ordinary Revenue any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sums hereinbefore appropriated together with the interest hereinbefore authorised on Treasury Bills the currency of which Bills may be in like manner extended in order to defray from the thirtieth day of June 1863 to the thirtieth day of June 1864 the like salaries charges and expenses as are hereinbefore mentioned Provided however that if the next session be not held before the thirtyfirst day of March 1864 this section shall be absolutely void and have no force or effect whatever.
