What is Wikivoyage?

Wikivoyage is a free web-based travel guide and advisory for travel destinations. It is free, Up to date, complete and Reliable.

It is a sister project of Wikipedia and supported and hosted by the Wikimedia Foundation (WMF)

The content is released under the creative Commons Copyleft licencing rules.

Wikivoyage has been called the "Wikipedia of travel guides"



History of Wikivoyage

It started in 2003 and was previously referred to as Wiki travel.

It was coined from the portmanteau of the word Wiki and Voyage.

Wikitravel was most active from 2003 through 2012, when most of its editing community left and brought their contributions to the nonprofit Wikivoyage guide.

The German and Italian part of Wikitravel pulled out to form Wikivoyage in 2005 and 2007 respectively.

The English Wikivoyage started in 2013.

Wikitravel Vs Wikivoyage

- Wikitravel was owned by Internet Brands.
- It shows advertisement.
- Wikivoyage is owned by the Wikimedia Foundation.
- It shows no advertisement.



Wikipedia Vs Wikivoyage

Wikipedia requires citation, could be on any encyclopedic topic, it is not restricted to travel. It does not have any page Banner.

Wikivoyage does not require citation, the opinion of the writer is trusted, it contains only travel topics.

- Visa and entry procedure e.g Travelling around the EU
- Festivals e.g <u>Music Festivals</u>
- <u>UNESCO World Heritage List</u>
- Concerns and Safety
- Travelling with children
- Working and volunteering

Introduction to different language with travel related phrases.

Wikivoyage Banner

Each Wikivoyage article starts with a banner.

A high quality panoramic photo.

There is no specific criterion for selecting an image to use in a banner.

It should be relevant to the destination or topic of the article.

For destination articles the image should be an accurate depiction of the location described.
