

- Self-reporting points, small prizes


Stats

- At start: 472 Wikipedia *pre-existing* articles (av. 12 articles per language). At end: over 1,300 articles (av. 34 p/l)
- Largest ever GLAM-Wiki comp; first WP+WD comp; 2nd largest translation comp (after CEE spring!)

- Metadata inconsistencies
 - “how many ways can use the same field”
- Notability of items
 - “It’s ‘Madonna and child’. Yes – which one.”
- EN.WP-centrism
 - ContentTranslation doesn’t support “campaigns”
- Engagement (chapters, individuals, GLAMs)


