1. THE Ritsumeikan Publishing Department supplies text-books of everykinds, general-books, and school requisites, in behalf of schools, (the Ritsumeikan schools) is engaged in publication and sale of instructive general books.

At the publishing department, there is established the editorial bureau, and engaged in editings of magazines and books,

Requisites of all courses of schools are all carried out under a contract of the publishing department.

2. THE publishing Dep. is made up of "chief", "manager" and "clerks", and they take charge of section business.

"chief", "manager" and "clerks" are appointed and dismissed by The president of Ritsumeikan (Ritsumeikan sōchō).

Remarks:

A. The editorial bureau has never been established, until discontinued business in the year of 1945, naturally during the period.

Manuscripts received by the "Chief", were only printed and book-bound. Thus editing and plans were all entrusted to the "Chief" autocracy.

B. "Chief" had been kept without "manager", "Clerks" attended to business of wide school's requisites appearing rather retail shopmen than clerks, and mainly engaged in sales of text-books and purchase of requisites.
