




The Star which at present is nearest the North Pole is *Abruccabah*, a Star of the second magnitude, and the last in the constellation of Ursa Minor; the Latitude of this Star is  $66^{\circ} 4' 43''$  and the mean Longitude, at the beginning of 1800, was  $85^{\circ} 46' 10''$ . Now the nearest approach of this Star to the Pole will be, when it is in the first of Cancer—which accordingly happens in the year 2103, at which time its distance from the pole will be about  $29' 55''$ . And since the fixed Stars complete a revolution about the axis of the ecliptic in 25816 years, therefore, any given fixed Star will perform half the revolution in half that time ; and consequently, if that Star was before at its nearest appulse to the pole, it will now be the most remote from it possible ; therefore, 12908 years after the year 2103, that is, in the year 15011, the present pole star will be  $45^{\circ} 33' 5''$  distant from the pole. About 2300 years before the common account of the commencement of the Christian æra, the star Draconis was the polar star, being then within ten minutes of the pole.

Mean place of the pole star from the first January 1827, is  $1^{\circ} 36' 50''$ , and its true place the first January, 1827, is  $1^{\circ} 36' 26''$ , and decreases yearly at the rate of  $19'' 9''$ .

## SOLAR AND LUNAR ECLIPSES, IN THE YEAR 1827.

**April 25**—The Sun Eclipsed, *invisible*, & at 9h 44m. evening. ☽ will be centrally Eclipsed on the Meridian at 10h. 22m. evening, in Longitude  $124^{\circ} 59'$  East, and Latitude  $57^{\circ} 30'$  North.

**May 11.**—The Moon Eclipsed, *Visible*.—Beginning of the Eclipse 1h 29m. morning.—Middle, 3h. 29m.—Ecliptic  $\delta$  3n. 7m.—End of the Eclipse, 4h. 35m.—Digits Eclipsed,  $11^{\circ} 47\frac{1}{2}$  on the ☽'s Southern Limb, or from the Northern side of the ☽'s shadow.

**October 20.**—The Sun Eclipsed *invisible*, ♀ at 10h. 29m. in Longitude  $6^{\circ} 26' 28\frac{3}{4}$  3-4m. ☽ Lat.  $48^{\circ} 3\frac{1}{4}$  South.—☽ will be centrally Eclipsed in the Meridian at 11h. 3m. morning, in Longitude  $65^{\circ} 14'$  West, and Lat.  $69^{\circ} 40'$  South.

**November 3.**—The Moon Eclipsed, *invisible*.—Beginning of the Eclipse 10h. 29m. morn. ☽'s upper Limb rises 11h. 26m.—Middle, 11h. 24m.—Ecliptic  $\delta$  11h. 55m.—End of Eclipse, 1h. 27m afternoon.—Digits Eclipsed  $10^{\circ} 35'$  in the ☽'s Northern Limb or from the Southern side of the Earth's shadow.

The Planet *Venus* will be Morning Star till the 9th October, and Evening Star for the rest of the year.

Planet *Jupiter*, Evening Star till the 30th March; Morning Star till the 19th October, and Evening Star for the rest of the year.




