
- Proposal to put this in a central place

- This is what you call an item




· Wikidata was born


- Links to Wikipedia


• A claim is a property -> right hand (can be item of some other type like string, image, coordinate)




- Claim with source added and here we have a qualifier
- This is called a statement



- Milkmaid!
- Previous statement is on the item about this painting
- Add link



- Here you see the different parts
- Difference between claim and statement

- Total of 13,M items. We have 2,8 million humans




- Butterflies (Glassy Tiger / Parantica aglea)



- Software still very much under construction
- Units, random access, query


- Wikipedia is much more mature

- Less rules, less politics, nice people
- We're exploring new ground here

# The Art & Architecture Thesaurus (AAT)®

Catherine wheel or rose window? AAT is a structured vocabulary, including terms, descriptions, and other information for generic concepts related to art, architecture, conservation, archaeology, and other cultural heritage.



## The Cultural Objects Name Authority (CONA)®

Mona Lisa or La Gioconda? CONA includes titles, attributions, depicted subjects, and other information about works of art and architecture as derived from scholarly literature, museum collections, special collections, archives, libraries, and indexing projects. CONA is linked to the AAT, TGN, and ULAN.



## The Getty Thesaurus of Geographic Names (TGN)®


London or Londinium? TGN is a structured vocabulary, including names, descriptions, and other information for current and historical administrative places and physical features important to art and architecture.




## The Union List of Artist Names (ULAN)®

Titian or Tiziano Vecellio? ULAN is a structured vocabulary, including names, biographies, related people, and other information about artists, architects, firms, studios, museums, patrons, sitters, and other people and groups involved in the creation and study of art and architecture.


- · Getty does authority control, we do to!
- We link to many. AAT is concepts, CONA is objects, TGN is locations, ULAN is people

- Viaf! Already a history on Wikipedia
- 550.000 links right now
- Viaf is switching from Wikipedia to Wikidata. YOU SHOULD DO THAT TOO!
- We also have the connected items (like NTA, 120.000) and we run bots

- A=Rijksmuseum creators, B=RKD artists, C=ULAN
- A=1527, B=25603, C=37364, A&B=1309, A&C=1261, B&C=15445, A&B&C=1220
- Overlap with different types of authority control
- For example Rijksmuseum painters which have ULAN and RKD

- Mix'n'Match is used to make initial matches
- Bot also do imports.
- Still a lot of work to do

- Sum of all paintings
- We of course have Mona Lisa! Is has an article in 97 languages
- The **WikiProject sum of all paintings** is a WikiProject to get an item for every painting in the collection of a museum

- Paintings that don't have a Wikipedia article (yet)
- Per collection import
- Much easier to create an item than to create an article
- Bots do import. All depends on data quality


- Bring together different collections
- For example this painter (Ludolf Bakhuizen) has works in Mauritshuis and Rijksmuseum

- To create a catalogue raisonné for every painter
- A **catalogue raisonné** is a comprehensive, annotated listing of all the known artworks by an artist either in a particular medium or all media. The works are described in such a way that they may be reliably identified by third parties.




- Autolist and autolist2

- User build and supported. Sometimes breaks





- We have games to get claims
