\* On 1/22/64, [NY 2233-S\*] (s) was informed that KAREL KYNCL, Czechoslovak representative for Radio Prague, was scheduled to hold an interview with MARK LANE on 1/23/64. MARK LANE is the former Assemblyman to the New York State Legislature and recently was retained by the family of LEE HARVEY OSWALD. (u) (s)

According to [NY 2233-S\*] (s), KYNCL will travel to Dallas, Texas, reason unknown, but it can be assumed that the visit will be for the purpose of conducting interviews relating to the OSWALD matter. (u) (s)

The Dallas Office will be advised of the date subject is expected in Dallas if this information comes to the attention of [NY 2233-S\*]. (s) In the meantime Dallas should alert its established sources, and make available to the Bureau and NYO any information developed. No surveillances on [KYNCL] is deemed necessary. (u) (s)
