Empty 55 gal drum situation is critical. Japanese contractors are unable to deliver more than 1,000 drums daily. Latest typhoon has seriously damaged drum manufacturing plants in the Kobe area, therefore, daily receipts from Japanese sources may be decreased. Imperative that action be taken to secure drums from sources outside Japan. Urgent need for 500,000 drums 55 gal. If the above drums are ordered from ZI suggest that 300,000 be ordered filled with diesel oil 50 octane 0 pour point, and 200,000 filled with mogas 80. These requirements are in addition to the 100,000 drums 80 octane mogas requested in letter, this headquarters, QMPFL 463.7, 15 July 50, subject: "Request for 80 octane mogas," and 200,000 drums diesel fuel requested on our slate 43.

Commanding General, Philippines Command (Air Force), APO 74

1. Paragraph 3d, SR 55-160-1, AFR 75-33, 22 June 1949 states,
in part;

"Generally, hold baggage containers will not exceed 40 cubic feet in size, and will consist of trunks, foot-lockers, and other containers. Canvas, pasteboard, and similar materials are not considered as affording adequate protection from pilferage and damage. Hold baggage will be incased in containers of sturdy, tough material which will afford maximum protection."

2. The above implies that:

a. Canvas, pasteboard and similar materials do not afford maximum protection against pilferage and damage without being boxed or crated.

b. Containers of pasteboard and similar materials are acceptable for shipment as hold baggage.

3. In connection with the above, the following is considered pertinent:

a. Commanding General, San Francisco Port of Embarkation message TCSFP 14046 OT, 11 April 1949, recommends that hold baggage shipped from the Far East Command not be boxed or crated inasmuch as the baggage cannot be shipped as free checkable baggage on the owner's ticket and that funds are not available to uncrate such baggage prior to forwarding to destination.

Ag 457 (26 Jun 50)TO, Subj: Shipment of Canvas, Pasteboard, and Similar Containers as Hold Baggage, 9 Sep 50

b. Duffel bags are the only item of issue that enlisted men may use for hold baggage containers.

c. A survey at the 2d Transportation Medium Port, Yokohama, established the fact that adequate measures have been placed in effect on transports to insure against pilferage of hold baggage at sea.

d. Pasteboard and similar containers are not considered suitable for the shipment of hold baggage because of the unquestionable damage which would result from the many handlings required between the point of origin and destination.

4. Accordingly, it was recommended that the Chief of Transportation, Department of the Army, give consideration to changing that portion of paragraph 3d, SR 55-160-1, AFR 75-33, 22 June 1949, quoted in paragraph 1, above, essentially as follows:

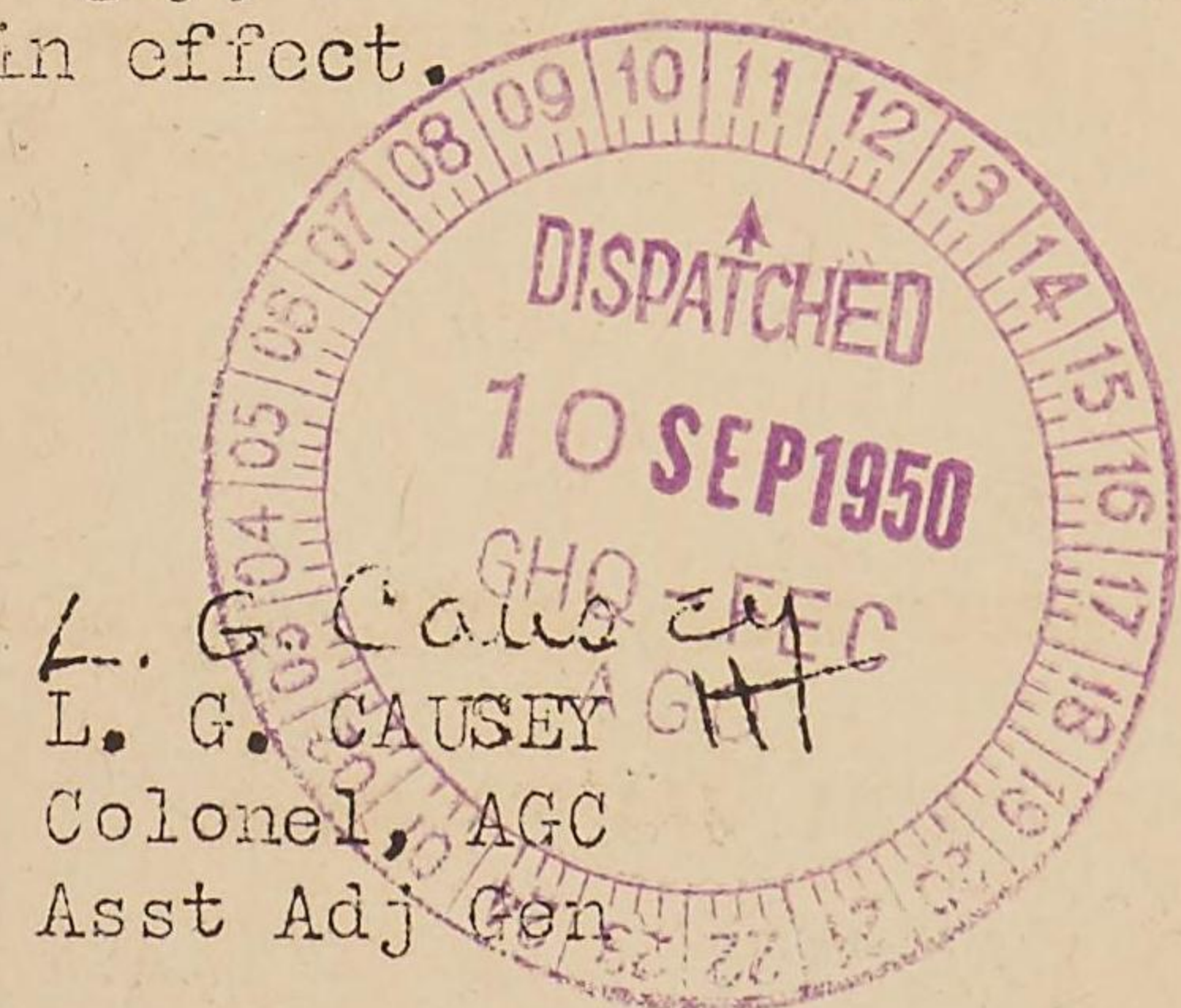
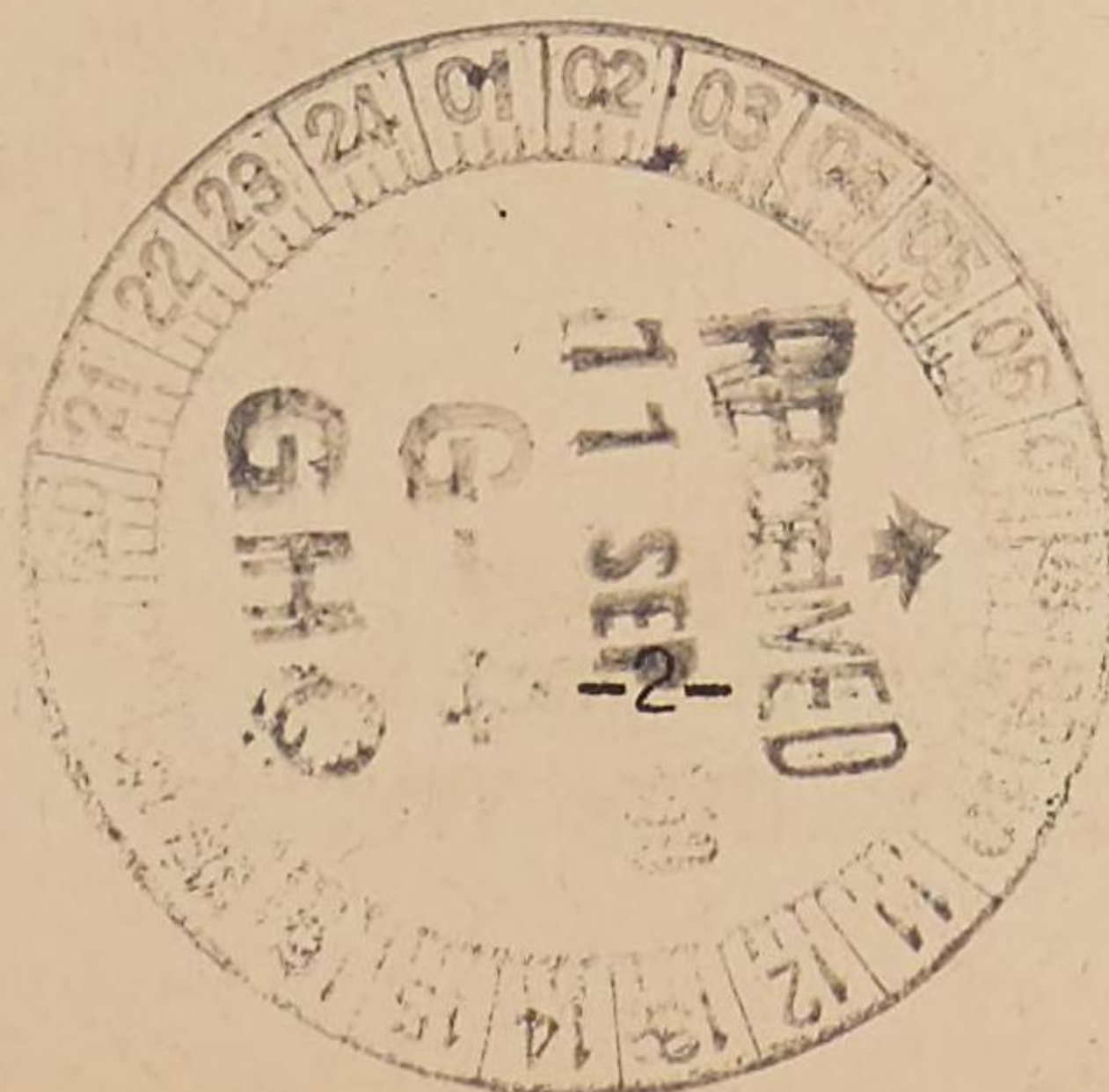
"Generally hold baggage containers will not exceed 40 cubic feet in size, and will consist of locked trunks, foot-lockers and other adequate containers of sturdy, tough material securely banded with steel strapping to afford maximum protection. Canvas and similar containers will be securely locked, but not boxed, crated, or banded. Pasteboard and similar containers do not afford adequate protection from pilferage or damage and will not be shipped as hold baggage."

5. In reply, the Chief of Transportation, Department of the Army advised that there is no objection to hold baggage being shipped from the Far East Command as outlined in paragraph 4, above, pending the issuance of instructions implementing proposed Joint Travel Regulations to be published pursuant to sec. 303 (h), Career Compensation Act of 1949.

6. Compliance with the provisions of paragraph 4, above, will result in greater efficiency and substantial saving of appropriated funds at the ports of embarkation. Accordingly, it is desired that when practicable this procedure be placed in effect.

1. There is an increasing and continuing requirement for petroleum containers of all types and sizes for use in the present emergency. Action has already been taken to procure some containers locally. In addition, local contracts have been awarded to effect the repackaging of lubes and greases into smaller, more convenient-size containers.

2. Informal information indicates the Quartermaster Board has undertaken considerable research on collapsible containers as well as flexible hose for use as pipeline. Factual information or experience data is desired on these items as well as similar information on recent developments on other allied petroleum storage and handling equipment.

3. It is requested that the information requested above be supplemented with advice on the availability of such items. It is believed that the present operation would provide a severe proving ground on subject items under combat conditions provided they have passed the experimental and testing phases and are available through normal supply channels.

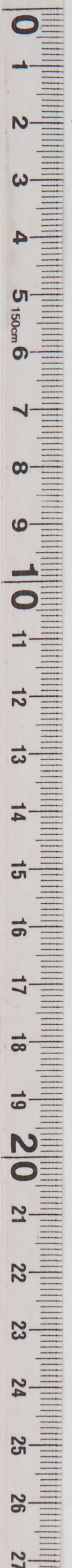

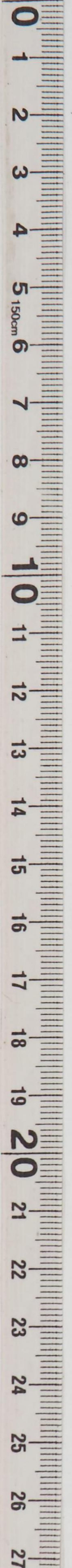

SUBJECT: Disposition of Air Lift Aluminum Drums

1. Sometime ago, the attention of GHQ was brought to the availability of approximately 1,400 aluminum drums as a result of the delivery of some oil to the Japanese civil economy. It was felt at that time that the drums might serve a useful purpose in the military scheme. Instructions were issued to recover these drums and maintain them in Eighth Army custody for possible use in an airlift of POL. While the referenced instructions are not readily available, the wording of basic letter indicates the Eighth Army recalls the incident.

2. Current inventories of containers make the basic letter appear to be inconsistent and instant Indorsement disapproves Eighth Army recommendation and instructs the Eighth Army to use subject drums for military needs.

3. This action is within established policy.

4. RYCOM is not affected by this action.
