## What would you use it for?

- 1. Add metadata to your pictures on Commons, in a structured, multilingual & machine-readable format (aka **depicts** and **captions**)
- 2. Organize **ISA tagging contests** in your community!

## Why does that tool exist?

To make Commons files easier to view, search, edit, organize and reuse, since 2019

It is **free** of charge, freely licenced, hosted on ToolForge

## Hootsuite in brief

#### What would you use it for?

Hootsuite is simply a social media management platform, that enables one to create posts on one or multiple social media platforms, schedule posts to go out at a stipulated date and time, and manage engagements on various social media platforms. These engagements include sending and replying Inbox messages, reacting or replying on comments, and deleting comments too. Hootsuite also helps you monitor activities within your niche of operation. It also helps you stay informed with market trends and competitors.

Hootsuite gives access to Twitter, Facebook (including Profiles, Events, Groups, and Fan Pages), LinkedIn (including Profiles, Pages, and Groups), Google+, Foursquare, WordPress blogs and several other platforms via third party apps (including Vimeo, Reddit, Via.me, StumbleUpon, Instagram, Tumblr, Evernote, Flickr, MailChimp, Slideshare, Storify, Edocr, Get Satisfaction, and others).

#### Why and when to adopt it?

You should use the Hootsuite platform if you wish to achieve the following:

- 1. Monitor Multiple Social Media Streams in One Place
- 2. Schedule posts in advance
- 3. Easily view analytics data
- 4. Share information easily
- 5. Social media listening
- 6. Efficiently manage customer service on social media
- Team collaboration



## Hootsuite in brief

#### Prerequisites and challenges?

- 1. You need to create an account. You can create an account using your Twitter, Facebook, or Google account, or you can create an account using a separate email address. Creating a personal account on HootSuite is free.
- 2. You need to add your social media networks, one by one
- 3. You need to add streams to be able to see the feeds of the social media networks you added.

#### How much?

#### The subscriptions cost are:

- 1. Professional \$49/month (1 user, 10 social media accounts, Unlimited posts, Post scheduling, Access to messages in one inbox)
- 2. Team \$249/month (3 users, 10 social media accounts, Unlimited posts, Post scheduling, Access to messages in one inbox, permissions, Assign posts to team members)
- 3. Business \$739/month (5 users, 35 social media accounts, Unlimited posts, Post scheduling, Access to messages in one inbox, permissions, Assign posts to team members, Approval workflows, Inbound/outbound tagging, Content & asset library, Hootsuite customer support)
- 4. Enterprise Custom (Starts at 5 users, 50 social media accounts, Unlimited posts, Post scheduling, Access to messages in one inbox, permissions, Assign posts to team members, Approval workflows, Inbound/outbound tagging, Content & asset library, Hootsuite customer support, Social ads management, Social ads analytics & reporting, Employee advocacy, Team productivity reporting)

Photo contests - local or international

- Need to liaise with a Wikimedia volunteer working on Montage to load it
- The results are calculated on averages, not on aesthetics the final round should be reviewed by all jurors and finals agreed

### What would you use it for?

**Increased security** for your sensitive information (passwords etc.)

- 1) only one master password to remember
- 2) encrypted data
- 3) vaults shared with your team members, for easier access to shared services (eg, twitter)
- 4) easier change of services password
- 5) alerts for weak password or hacked passwords

## Why and when to adopt it?

When the team grows and sharing passwords within the teams drives you crazy... When your website was hacked AGAIN! (due to a weak, multi-used password....)

# Streamyard in brief

## What would you use it for?

- It is an accessible Outside Broadcast platforms that streams content directly to social media spaces
- Streaming live conversations, chats, presentations, webinars, etc.
- Pre-recording conversations, chats, presentations, webinars, etc.

## Why and when to adopt it?

- When you want to coordinate discussions with people who are not in the same room or even country
- Presentable format to allow different viewpoints
- When you have a larger audience than just the people in the room
