
Sir,

I beg to inform you that I have today forwarded by Commercial Papers Post "first entry report" on the new steamer "OTTAR", also a report on "the electric light installation" and "freeboard verification" form. All the approved plans of the vessel was forwarded with my freeboard report of last month.

On my last visit to Fevig last week, I was informed that the vessel was to leave for Middlesbrough by the end of the week in order to have her machinery installed, without the windlass, which the Fevigs Jern-Skibshyggeri has not been able to obtain on account of a strike in England. I am however now informed that the windlass is to be installed before the vessel leaves Fevig, probably at the end of this week, but is not likely to be examined by me.
