**Eleventh and Broad  
Downtown Columbus in 1895**

The old firetower was a landmark standing in the middle of Broad. The white painted building was made of iron shipped to Columbus from Pittsburgh. It housed the Georgia Home Insurance Company and the first National Bank in Columbus. The building became known later as THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK and still houses that company's office at this intersection.
