





doordinator, a group of h VG-9h RM-2's and 7 VG-9h, led, as air ever le to support the landing made that morning. The initial target assigned consisted of a group of tembs in an area 30x700 yds. believed to contain numerous emplacements. 32 tons of bombs, 150 AR, and 1500 rds. .50 cal. were expended in 29 sorties, sith unobserved results. The group next strafed a cave area 1000 yds. long, results also unknown. Incidental targets consisted of 2 shacks housing Jap personnel, each of which was strafed and fired by 1 VF and a 22 ton truck which was strafed and seriously damaged.
