

CHARTER.

ARTICLE PREMIER. That the name and title of the Corporation hereby formed is declared to be "Henderson Investment Co. Limited".

ARTICLE SECOND. That the objects and purposes for which this Corporation is established and the nature of the business to be carried on by it are hereby declared to be buying, selling and dealing in...

ARTICLE THIRD. That the Capital Stock of this Corporation is hereby fixed at the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) divided into shares of five hundred (\$500) shares of the par value of one hundred dollars (\$100) each.
