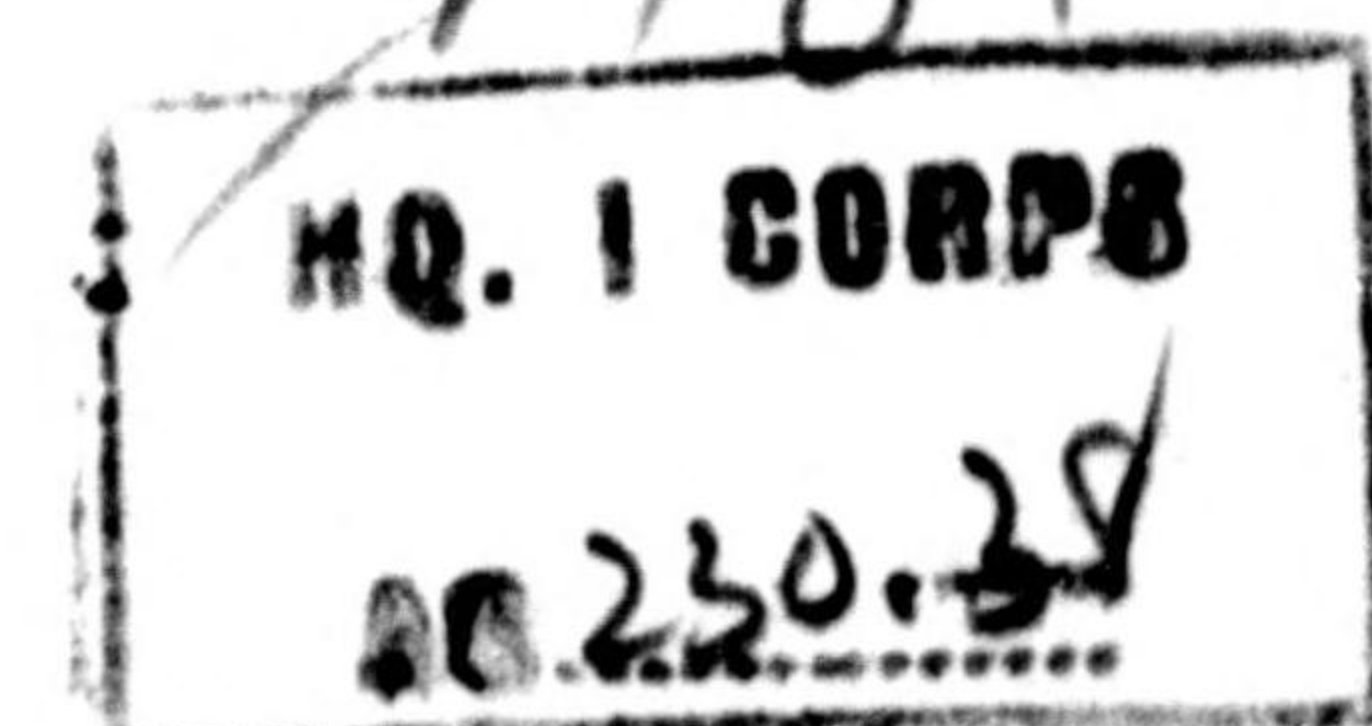

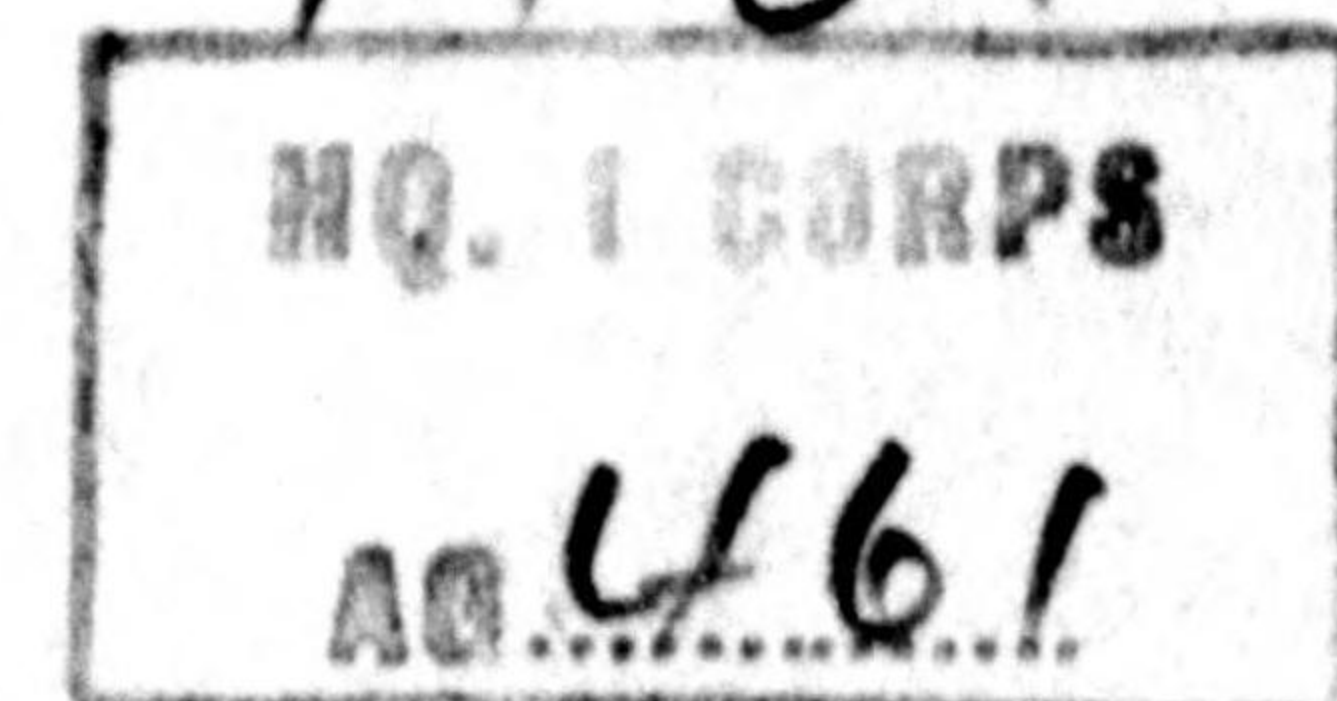

1. Upon the completion of hospitalization, 26 September 1947, of Maggie Smith, a foreign national employed in your offices, a bill was rendered. Inasmuch as this patient was unable to pay her bill, and this hospital would have been unable to accept yen in payment thereof, the matter was referred to Headquarters, Far East Command.

2. Under date of 24 October 1947, the following information was received as a 1st Ind to our letter:

"1. Reference is made to paragraph 2 of basic communication. Inasmuch as Maggie Smith is not paid a salary in military payment certificates, it is assumed that she is not classified as a civilian employee of the United States Government and is, therefore, not authorized hospitalization in an United States Army hospital.

2. It is requested that the employment status of all personnel be checked carefully prior to their admission. In this connection, your attention is invited to par. 6, AR 40-590 and par. 4, Cir 85, General Headquarters, Far East Command, 1947.

3. This account is uncollectible and should be written off as authorized in par. 12a (2) (d), AR 40-590."

3. In the future, this hospital will be unable to render medical service to foreign nationals in the same classification as Maggie Smith.

Employment: Units desiring to employ foreign nationals after receipt of information from Military Government that applicant is employable will submit a position description (WD Form No. 74) in quaduplicate accompanied by WD Form No. 72 (Civilian Personnel Action Request) direct to Headquarters 8th Army OCP for grading. Units will be notified when Foreign National must report to Civilian Personnel Section, Yokohama for processing.

The applicant must take with him the following fully completed forms when presenting himself for processing:

- ✓ b. WD Form No. 79 - Personnel History Statement
- c. WD AGO Form No. 03 - Report of Physical Examination

Until processing is accomplished payment for services will not be made.

4. Time Sheet: Time for Foreign Nationals will be submitted on Form O OCP-1 as per instructions on the reverse side of the form. Foreign Nationals time reports will be conspicuously marked "foreign National."

Form O OCP-1 covers two calendar weeks so it will be necessary to use three sheets to make up a thirty or thirty-one day month. Dates must be indicated in the spaces provided.

Complete mailing address of employing unit must be shown on Form O OCP-1.

Vouchers will be prepared and forwarded as is now being done for U.S. Civil Service employees. Class A agents or suitable local arrangement may be used to effect payment to the individual.

The letter A or B will be inserted in the quarters class column to indicate whether or not subsistence is being furnished:

The duty station of the individual must be shown in the remarks column to establish any area differential payable. Generous use of explanatory remarks is encouraged.

1. Employee's Relief Ordinance Number 382 is interpreted
as follows:

a. Injuries and disease incurred in the line of duty
and during duty hours.

(1) Cost of medical care and medication will be
paid by Japanese Government.

(2) Other benefits enumerated in the ordinance,
such as sick benefits, etc., will be made
available to him.

b. Accidental injuries in line of duty and during
duty hours.

(1) The cost of medical care and medication
will be paid by Japanese Government.

(2) If, however, the injury was received as a
result of willful negligence on the part of
the employee, he is not entitled to the
benefits enumerated in the act, nor to the
free medical care.

(3) In the event there is a dispute between
the employee and the Japanese Government
as to whether the act which caused the in-
jury is willful negligence, appeal proce-
dures are available as provided in the act.

c. Accidental injuries and diseases incurred out-
side line or hours of duty.


(1) Cost of medical care and medication will
be borne by individual employee. Treat-
ment may be received at clinics and hospi-
tals established and designated to give
required physical examinations at a mini-
mum cost to the employee, as ruled by
Ministry of Welfare ruling in May 1946.

Subject: Charges for Treatment of Occupation Force Employees.

- (2) Employees will receive full salary or wage for a period not to exceed 90 days, provided he gives his employer written notice of reasons for his absence, and submits a medical certificate in explanation. This benefit is provided by CLO memorandum entitled "Salaries, Wages, and Allowances of the Permanent Employees for the Allied Forces," issued 1 June 1947, retroactive to 16 March 1947.

2. Medical care referred to above is available to Japanese Nationals employed by Occupation Forces in those clinics and hospitals designated to perform required physical examinations.

3. It is to be further noted that many employees belong to National Health Insurance groups, and when injuries or disease is incurred they are eligible to benefits as provided by his group coverage. In those instances where an injured employee is not entitled to benefits under Ordinance Number 382 he may belong to National Health Insurance, in which event he may be reimbursed anywhere from 40% to 80% of the cost of medical care. These benefits are of considerable importance, particularly in non-occupational injuries and diseases.

TO : Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, APO 500
Attn: Public Health and Welfare Section

1. In accordance with OD 41, 6 May 1947 clinics for the examination of occupation force employees have been established and hospitals have been designated to furnish medical care to these employees.
2. In our recent conversation with the Chief of Public Health and Welfare Section, SCAP, it was understood that examinations and treatment would be done free to the employee, the charges being paid by the Japanese Government. However, the Ken officials and the Central Liaison Office representative interpret the Employee's Relief Ordinance Number 382, to mean that treatment can only be free to those who strictly contract their disease or injury in the line of duty and during working hours. Injury incurred by the employee accidentally is always considered negligence and the employee is charged. Disease incurred by the employee which cannot definitely be proven to be occupational in origin is considered the responsibility of the individual.
3. It is the opinion of this office that no benefits will be obtained by the employee by such strict interpretation of this ordinance. Clarification of the benefits due the employee under the "Employees Relief Ordinance, Number 382" is requested.






