Lieut. (jg) J. F. BATES in a **FB4Y-1P** aircraft took off from **Agana Airfield, Guam, H. I.** on **1 May 1945** at **0645 King** to photograph enemy installations on **Marcus Island**. He arrived over his target at **1200 King**. The weather was clear with visibility unlimited. He took vertical and oblique photographs of the airfield areas of **Marcus Island**. No antiaircraft or enemy interceptor was encountered.

Lieut. (jg) BATES returned to base at **1745 King**.
