Subject: Report on the Present Situation of the Plant.

The Kobe Kosakusho K.K. Miki Plant was constructed as a dispersal plant in 1945, and began the business in May, 1945.

At the termination of War, we closed the plant.

In November 1945, we had the application from the Okada Kinzoku Kogyosho K.K. Miki town, the manufacturer of agricultural implement and woodworking tools, to lease the building of the plant and made the contract to lease the plant.


In May, 1946 the Miki plant was appointed as a reparation plant, and we began the maintenance work of machine tools in the plant.

It was difficult to maintain the machine in good condition in Miki plant, and we applied the permission to transport all the reparation machine tools to our Akashi plant, and got the permission from the Hyogo Military Government on 1st Aug. 1946 File No. 67-46.

At present no reparation machine nor productive installation and materials of Kobe Kosakusho are left in the Miki plant.

On Nov. 1946 we made the application for authorized permission to lease the plant to the Hyogo Military Government. We got the information through the Hyogo Prefectural Office that the buildings of the plant was returned to the owner. The machine tools should be maintained as a reparation subject in the Akashi plant.

We report the present situation of the plant with the copy of permission.

Subject: Return of ground, buildings of the plant.

The Hyogo Prefectural Office received the directive from the Hyogo Military Government, Commerce and Industry Section, dated 25th Nov. 1946, No.B-6 that your Miki plant was removed from the restriction for operation.

The Hyogo Prefectural Office decided to return the ground and buildings of the plant to your firm and we hereby give you the information.

In this case all the machine tools already transported from this plant are subject to reparation and will be maintained by your firm.

SUBJECT: re MIKI PLANT of KOBE KOSAKUSHO, designated as
a reparation factory.

TO : Headquarters, 31st Military Government Team.

Sirs,

We take pleasure in apprising you that the above plant was designated on 22 May, 1946, as one of the reparation factories, nominally belonged to the Kobe Kosakusho, but in reality the plant was in possession of the Okada Metal Co., Ltd.

The fact is that the Kobe Kosakusho leased a part of the plant from the Okada Metal Co., Ltd. and used it as only a warehouse for the machinery estranged from the seat of war. It is a matter of course that no reparations were made by the Kobe Kosakusho. Soon after this the war came to an end, the Kobe Kosakusho were notified by the Hyogo Prefectural Government under its notification "H51-TOKU-BUTSU" #545 as per the attached sheet that the restriction to the use of land and building was released, therefore, the Kobe Kosakusho at once moved the estranged machinery to their plants in Kobe and Akashi and vacated the warehouse to the Okada Metal Co., Ltd. on 3rd November, 1946.

In short, the plant in question is one storied, tile-roofed, wooden building which covers an area of 48 tsube.

Granting that the plant was in possession of the Kobe Kosakusho, we consider it too poor to be designated as a reparation plant, but things that are useable when taken to pieces are such as enumerated in the attached sheet.
