Inspection of Reparation Plants

2 Dec. 1948

(1) Hokuriku Kikai, Iburibashi Plant

a) Guards alert

b) About fifteen machines having U-marks were not in operation. They explained the reason as follows.

"We were given ^{the permit} to make 50 lobbies a month and have been working them until now. Meanwhile the efficiency of production has been increased by and by and the plant has not wanted to employ new mechanics when some of them retired from this plant due to their own private circumstances. The plant submitted an application ^{on 10 May 1948} for making parts of power looms which were being manufactured in the main plant.

If the permit for the above application is given we can use all U-marked machines fully. So we want to retain them all as they are.

c) They have 32 Ex-machines in all.

We investigated again why they should be Ex-marked. According to the invoice made by Mr. Kiichi Nagasawa, chief of Kanagawa branch, Nippon Express Co. These machines were shipped from Kanagawa to Iburibashi on 29 July 1945. There were no documentary evidences concerning the arrival at Iburibashi.

(2)

They said that some machines might have arrived at the plant ^{before 15 Aug. 1945} and the others must have arrived there after the same date. This plant was designated as a reparation plant on 18 Nov. 1946 and when the inventory business was started in January 1947 the Ishikawa Co. authorities judged and decided these 32 machines as Ex-machines. They must have supposed these machines were not used for munition work during the war.

There was a testing machine which was shipped from Kanagawa to Huribashi on 29 July 1945. This machine belonged to the main plant and inventoried on 14 Nov. 1946 in the main plant at first.* So when the main plant was released this machine ought to have been released.

The Huribashi plant was designated as reparation plant at the same time (there might be some days between the designation and release) the main plant was released.

* (It looks to me that it was mistaken to inventory this testing machine at the beginning because this machine was dispersed to Huribashi plant prior to the date the main plant was taken under custody and control and the Huribashi plant was not listed for reparation at that time.)

After the main plant was released this machine must have been released too.

But in case of inventory of Furubashi plant they inventoried this machine, as a reparation item on 12 Jan. 1947 (by draft).

If everything in the designated plant is reparation item, this machine should be inventoried and must not be exempted however it may belong to the main plant.

What is the final decision?

We found a very funny case in this plant.

No. 47 machine is said to be brought there in July 1945 and yet we found a tag in which the date of manufacture was written as 7 Nov. 1940.

We supposed that the tag which was made in the main plant was mistaken or the machine was brought there before completion.

(2) Daini Kogyo K.K.

Guards looked alert.

It is still very difficult to get every cloth for polishing and they wished the M.G.'s help in getting them. We called both chiefs of guard and labor sections and investigated about the matter of letting so many workers get in the plant without passes.

Until sometime ago the M.G. team issued a letter of admittance for the plant's employees. Then the plant issues individual identification card & this card is considered as passes in entrance.

If the chief of labor section ^{only} issued this card for members who ^{get} permit nothing of this

kind should have happened. The above-mentioned identification card means only that the man who has it is an employee of this plant. The guard, however, thought it to be substitute of a pass. I think that the cause of this misconduct is due to the fact there was no intimate contact between labor section and guards and the chief of labor section should be responsible for the president.

The president ^{and both} chiefs of labor section and guards, ^{cordially} apologized for the A.S. in committing this ^{such} crime and swore they would never make mistake in the future.

We investigated the whole plant chiefly both U marked and Ex machines

List No. 1. Wood working machines & Equipments

33 wood working machines are to be U marked this time. As they were being used except a few machines which of course will be run when they make iron ^{rim} wheels.

List No. 2. Casting machines & others.

Except 3 sand mills, (909, 910 & 911) all other equipments ^(17 items) were being used. So they wished the A.S. would permit to mark U on them.

No 916 was to be used only in winter time owing to shortage of electricity.

List No. 3. Small Motors (under 5 HP)

They ^{first} requested to mark U on 14 small motors but one (941) need not be U-marked because

The drilling machine to which this motor belonged was canceled from authorized machines.

So 12 small motors should be U-marked this time and the rest (5 motors) should have only numbers.

List No. 4. Miscellaneous Equipments.

Two oil tanks (946, 947) should be Ex-marked according to Cite 010515/2.

Two water tanks (948, 949) should be U-marked.

Two stokers (950, 951) should have only numbers.

This list was submitted to Mr. [unclear] when he visited this plant.
