A dive bombing attack was made from 7,000 feet into a sixty degree dive. All bombs were relieased at 1,500 feet with pulloute approximately 1,000 feet. All bombs made hits in the assigned target area, but due to heavy foliage, results were unobserved other than one direct hit on a small building destroying half of it. He enemy opposition was met, and all planes returned in good order, other than one which landed at Dulag, Letye due to a shortage of gas.
