- 1. Reference is made to paragraph 1c to Annex IVI to Memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, file AG 370.05 (7 May 46)GC, (SCAPIN-927), dated 7 May 1946, subject: "Repatriation," as amended.
- 2. It has been reported that in some cases Koreans are forfeiting their privilege of repatriation due to insufficient time to prepare
  for movement to the reception center.
- 3. The Imperial Japanese Government will give Koreans a minimum of fifteen (15) days notice for movement to the designated reception center in preparation for repatriation.
