5 221 BILLS WILL GO TO CURRENT DIET

Vice-Ministers Decide on Schedule as Lawmakers End Recess Jan. 21

A total of 221 bills will be submitted to the Diet after the New Yearls recess ends on January 21, Cabinet vice-ministers decided Thursday at its first 1951 conference.

Of these measure, 44 will be submitted by Diet members.

The vice-ministers decided that the Local Taxation Law should be further revised so as to ensure an increase in tax revenues through better tax collection methods. Last year's local tax revenues totaled ¥190,800,000,000, and this year's are estimated at ¥208,700,000,000.

Although they conferred on means of increasing shipping space, no agreement was reached. The subject will be taken up again at a later meeting.
