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S U M M A R Y O F C O N T E N T S

Medical Records, Mukden Prisoner of War Camp
(Docs 2820, 2821, 2822, 2823)

This report consists of translations of four separate documents, numbered as above, all of which are certificates or signed statements emanating from the Medical Office, Mukden Prisoner of War Camp, with dates from 1943 to 1945. Summaries of the documents are as follows.

Docs 2820, 2821. These two documents have been combined into one continuous translation. They make up a handwritten carbon-copied file entitled "Witnessed Certificates of Diagnosis (Prisoners of War)" and are dated 1944 and 1945 respectively. There are 82 certificates listing the names of Allied prisoners of war. The certificates deal with the following cases:

1. 5 death certificates (7 American, 1 Australian) certifying death from natural causes. Probably negligence by the Japanese medical authorities is suggested by Certificate No 1 (Pvt A. J. Carver, USA--died of malaria and beri-beri of 14 months' duration), Certificate No 3 (Pfc J. T. Beserra, USA--died of acute inflammation of kidneys of 12 months' duration) and Certificate No 8 (Col D. C. Pigdon, RAAMC--request for post-mortem examination signed by Air Vice-Marshal P. G. Maltby (?), RAF, and Maj Gen C. A. Callaghan (?), AIF, attached to certificate).

2. Death diagnosis certificates Nos 9 - 27, giving statements of the deaths of 17 American and 2 British prisoners of war as a result of bombing on 7 Dec 1944.

3. Death certificates Nos 28 - 46, certifying the deaths of the above 19 prisoners of war as a result of bombing attack by B29s on 7 Dec 1944.

4. Wound certificates Nos 47 - 82, listing casualties incurred amongst prisoners of war as a result of same attack.

Pages 1 through 43

Doc 2822. This is a 29-page handwritten and typed file (in English and Japanese), "Documents of Evidence (Relief Supplies - Medical)," dated 1943 - 1945. It includes a list of relief supplies sent by the Japan Delegation of the International Red Cross Committee, Geneva, with each consignment countersigned by a prisoner of war as having been received. There are also four pages listing relief supplies sent by the No 1 Branch Office at Cheng-Chia-T'un.

Pages 45 through 55

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Doc 2823. This is a file of ten handwritten slips (in English) entitled "Medical Equipment Reasons for breakage File - Relief Supplies", dated Apr - Jul 1945. Each slip is a statement, with explanation, of the breakage of certain medical equipment at the camp, written by a prisoner of war. A Japanese translation of the article broken and the prisoner's number is appended, together with the seal of a Japanese medical sergeant.

Note: Further medical documents which furnish a roster of additional prisoners of war at this camp are in process of translation and are to appear shortly as a further "War Crimes Information Series" report.
