In item of Okayama-ken, "Konoshimasoto-mura" in Oda-gun shall be deleted.

In item of Nagasaki-ken, "Tsukino-kawa-mura" in Kitamatsuura-gun shall read "Tsukinokawa-machi."

Cabinet Order No. 78

Cabinet Order for Partial Amendments to the Imperial Ordinance concerning the Restriction of Securities Holdings, etc. by Companies

In accordance with the Imperial Ordinance relating to the Orders to be issued in consequence of the Acceptance of the Potsdam Declaration (Imperial Ordinance No. 542 of 1945), the Cabinet establishes the present Cabinet Order.

Imperial Ordinance concerning the Restriction of Securities Holdings, etc. by Companies (Imperial Ordinance No. 567 of 1946) shall be partially amended as follows:

The following one (1) Article shall be ad-

ded next to Article 13-(2):

Article 13–(3). Designated Companies, Subsidiary Companies or Affiliated Companies shall not change their trade names without the approval of the Holding Company Liquidation Commission, provided that this prohibition shall not be applicable where an order for the change of trade name has been issued by the Holding Company Liquidation Commission pursuant to the provisions of Article 14.

Article 17–(2) shall become Article 17–(4) and in the same Article, "Articles 2, 3, 11, 13, 13–(2) and 14–(2) shall read "Articles 2, 3, 11, 13 to 13–(3) inclusive, 14–(2) and 17–(2)" and the proviso to the same Article shall be deleted.

Article 17–(3) shall be Article 17–(5), in the same Article, "provided that as for a successor company of a subsidiary company or an affiliated company such shall be applicable only while such subsidiary company or affiliated company is a subsidiary company or affiliated company." shall be deleted; and "Article 17–(3)" shall read "Article 17–15."

The following two (2) Articles shall be added next to Article 17:

Article 17–(2). The provisions of Articles 2, 3, 11, 13 to 13–(3) inclusive and 14–(2) shall apply mutatis mutandis with respect to a company which was a designated company or its subsidiary company or affiliated company until the date when one (1) year has passed since the date when such designated company (increase, as regards a subsidiary

company or affiliated company, there are two or more designated companies, it shall be construed as meaning all of such companies; hereinafter the same in this Article) has been released frcm the designation as a designated company. In this case, after such designated company has been released from designation as a designated company, "another company" in Articles 2, 3 and 11 shall read "another company which is or was in the same chain of capital with such company (including any company which has become an affiliated company in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 3 of Article 1, in the relation with a company which is or was in such same chain of capital; hereinafter the same); in Article 13, "any other company than those concerned" shall read "another company which is or was in the same chain of capital with such company"; and in Article 14-(2), "non-designated company" shall read "another company which is or was in the same chain of capital with such company and which is not or was not a designated company."

Article 17–(3). The provisions of Articles 4, 5 and 15 shall apply mutatis mutandis with respect to those companies which receive application of the provisions of the preceding Article. In this case, "at the time of enforcement of this Imperial Ordinance" in these provisions shall read "at the time of enforcement of the provisions of Article 17–(3)."

The provisions of Article 12 shall be apply mutatis mutandis with respect to a company which has been released from designation as a designated company and which receives application of the provisions of the preceding Article. In this case, "the date of enforcement of this Imperial Ordinance" in the same Article shall read "the day of enforcement of the provisions of Article 17–(3)."

"(Inclusive of cases wherein these provisions apply mutatis mutandis in Article 17–(2)" shall be added next to "the provisions of Article 2 or 3" in item 1 of Article 18 and next to "the provisions of Article 13 and the former part of paragraph 1 of Article 13 and the former part of paragraph 1 of Article 14–(2)" in item 6 of the same Article and also after "Article 13–(2)" in item 7 of the same Article; and in items 2 to 4 inclusive of the same Article, "Article 17 or Article 17–(3)" shall read "Article 17, 17–(3) or 17–(5)."

In items 1 to 3 inclusive and 6 of Article 19, "Article 17 or Article 17-(3)" shall read "Article 17, 17-(3) or 17-(15)" and "(inclusive of cases wherein these provisions

apply mutatis mutandis in Article 17-(2)" shall be added next to "Article 11" in item 5 of the same Article and next to "the latter part of paragraph 1 of Article 14-(2)" in item 7 of the same Article.

Supplementary Provisions:

1. The present Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

2. Part of the Holding Company Liquidation Commission Ordinance (Imperial Ordinance No. 233 of 1946) shall be amended as follows:

In this case the term "within two (2) months of the day of enforcement of this

Cabinet Ordinance" in these provisions shall read "within one (1) month of the day of enforcement of the provisions of Article 17–3 of the Ordinance."

The holder of such stocks as prescribed in the preceding paragraph shall submit a stock disposal plan to the Holding Company Liquidation Commission with respect to such stocks within two (2) months of the day of enforcement of the provisions of Article 17–(3) of the Ordinance.

The provisions of paragraphs 2 to 4 inclusive of Article 22, Articles 25 and 26 shall apply mutatis mutandis to the stock disposal plan of the preceding paragraph.

Article 32–(3). The provisions of Article 31 shall apply mutatis mutandis to a company which receives application of the provisions of Article 17–(3) of the Ordinance. In this case, "designated date" in Article 31 shall read "the date of enforcement of the provisions of Article 17–(3) of the Ordinance."

In paragraphs 1 and 2 of Article 22 and in

In paragraphs 1 and 2 of Article 33 and in Article 34, "Article 17–(3) of the Ordinance" shall read "Article 17–(5) of the Ordinance."

Article 36 shall be Article 37 and the following one (1) Article shall be added next to Article 35:

Article 36. A company which desires to receive approval on the change of trade name in accordance with the provisions of Article 13-(3) (inclusive of cases wherein these provisions are applied mutatis mutandis in Article 17-(2) of the Ordinance shall submit an application for approval of change of trade name stating the following particulars to the Holding Company Liquidation Commission:

Address and trade name of the applicant;
 Amount of capital of the applicant;

3. Whether the applicant is or was a designated company, subsidiary company, affiliated company or successor company to these:

4. Outline of the business conducted by the applicant;

5. Trade name after the change;

6. Reasons necessitating the change of trade name;

7. Other relevant facts.

The following documents shall be attached to the application for approval of change of trade name of the preceding paragraph.

1. A copy of record of resolution of general meeting of shareholders or other document similar thereto concerning the change of trade name;

2. Articles of Incorporation.

AICHI PREFECTURE Approval of Association

March 31, 1949

Following is the Regulation of Nagoya Horserace Truck Management Association passed Aichi Prefectural Assembly at the regular session in Feb. 1949 and which was approved by Prime Minister:

> Nagoya Horse-race Truck Management Association

Chapter 1 General Rules

(Name of association)

Article 1. This association shall be called Nagoya Horse-race Truck Management Association.

(Local public organizations which form the association)

Article 2. This association shall be organized by Aichi Prefecture and Nagoya City.

(Business to be jointly disposed by the ass.)

Article 3. This association shall jointly dispose of business concerning construction and management of Nagoya Horse-race Truck located at Tsuchifuru-cho, Minato-ku, Nagoya City.

(Location of office of the assn.)

Article 4. The location of the assn. shall be in prefectural office or city office to which the manager of the assn. belongs.

Chapter 2 Council of the Association

(Fixed number and election of councillors)

Article 5. The fixed number of councillors of the assn. shall be sixteen and prefecture and city shall elect eight each at assembly meeting from among respective assemblymen.

2 The date to execute the election shall be decided by the manager and shall be notified to governor or mayor concerned.

3 Governor or mayor concerned shall report immediately the result of the election to the manager when it is executed according to paragraph 1 of this Article.

(Term of office of councillors)

Article 6. Term of office of the councillors shall be two years, however, in case of expiration of office term as assembly-men of Aichi Prefecture or Nagoya City during the term of office as councillors, it shall expire automatically, too.

(By-election)

Article 7. In case of occurrence of a vacancy of the councillor of the assn., by-election shall be carried out.

2 Provisions of pars. 2 and 3 of Art. 5 shall be applied to the election.

Chapter 3 Executive Organ of the Association

(Structure of executive organ)

Article 8. This assn. shall have one manager, two assistant managers, one treasurer and one assistant treasurer.

2 Term of office of manager, assistant manager, treasurer and assistant treasurers shall be two years, however, in case of expiration of office term as governor, mayor, lieutenant governor, assistant mayor, chiefaccountant, treasurer of city, assistant chief accountant or assistant treasurer of city, during term of office as officials of the assn., it shall expire automatically, too.

3 Except the officers provided for in par. 1 of this Article, this association shall have necessary number of employees and the number shall be stipulated in Routine Regulations.

(Election of personnel of executive organ)

Article 9. Manager of the assn. shall be elected from either governor of Aichi Pref. or Mayor of Nagoya City.

2 Assistant managers shall be elected one each from lieutenant governors of the prefecture and assistant mayors of the city. And treasurer and assistant treasurer shall be appointed from chief accountant of pref. or treasure of city and assistant chief accountant of pref. or assistant treasurer of city respectively, whom the governor or mayor governs.

3 Employees stipulated in par. 3 of preceding Article shall be appointed or discharged by the manager.

Chapter 4 Expenditure of the Association

(Method of payment of expenditure)

Article 10. The expenditure for this assn. shall be borne as below:

Aichi Prefecture Nagoya City 50%

Supplementary Provisions:

This Regulation shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

In the initial election of councillors under this regulation, manager of assn. in par. 2 of Art. 5 shall be interpreted as the Governor Aichi Prefecture.
