Tech Habits


She first started using a computer in grade school, and got her first smartphone in high school. She uses social media avidly, particularly Twitter to share her work and writing, and to follow other


environmental groups. She is well-known by her online username, "jigu". She learned basic HTML to run her website, and uses Adobe software for her graphic design and art.

Perceptions of Wikipedia

She first used Wikipedia in university, and then started to use it more frequently while researching fantasy literature and inspiration for her art. She mostly uses English and Japanese Wikipedia, because she often finds incorrect

translations or limited information on Korean Wikipedia. She sees Wikipedia as a formal, proper source of information, compared to other websites like Namuwiki which is more opinionated, but also more relaxed and collaborative.

Background

Tech Habits

Yanko feels comfortable using and exploring new online platforms. He uses Google Maps and Mapy. cz to plan out his bike trips. He uses Facebook to connect with friends and share photos, and likes that he can leave traces of his daily life. He uses YouTube to find and listen to new music. Whenever he wants to learn something new, he goes first

to Google and reads the top results of his search. He spends a lot of time reading about science and German history online. He used to contribute to an online forum where he would review, post photos of, and create maps for bike trails in the Czech Republic.

Perceptions of Wikipedia

He has "always" known about Wikipedia. He looks a lot of things up on Wikipedia reflexively, such as bands, history, new science topics, etc. He uses mostly Czech Wikipedia, sometimes German for German history, and sometimes English for things that are not on Czech (which he read through Google Translate). He thinks Wikipedia is an amazing source of information and uses it whenever he's studying something new.

Experience Goals


- To progressively make more advanced edits, so that he can become a more technically skilled editor
- To be a part of and participate in Wikipedia's collaborative process


End Goals

Background

Josef lives in Prague and works as a data analyst for a media company. He has been married for 24 years and has a 18-year-old daughter. He's interested in history and politics, and likes to read nonfiction books on Czech, Slovak, and Polish history. On the weekends, he spends time with his family, visits the library and local museums, and practices his photography.

Tech Habits

At work, Josef uses a desktop computer with an external mouse, monitor, and keyboard, on which he mostly uses Excel and a statistical software for his work. He reads the news every day online, and will sometimes comment on news articles about current events. At home, he has a laptop comput-

er where he searches on Seznam.cz (a Czech web portal) and Google for more information about the historical events he's currently reading about. He has a Facebook account but mostly browses it for updates from friends and family and doesn't post.

Perceptions of Wikipedia

He often uses Wikipedia when searching for information on historical and political events. He thinks Wikipedia is a good starting point for him to learn about a new topic and will use the reference index to find additional sources. He mostly uses Czech Wikipedia, but will sometimes use English, Slovak, or Polish Wikipedia, because he thinks Czech has

limited information and because each of these Wikipedias have their own cultural perspective. Josef believes that only people who have credentials in their field should edit, and assumes that there is a committee that reviews content. He learned that anyone could edit from a news article about Wikipedia.

Experience Goals


 To make edits quickly and easily withou having to put in effort to learn new content or how to edit

End Goals

 To correct obvious inaccuracies or mistakes that he finds while reading Wikinedia

Challenges

- Feels that he's not qualified to make more substantial edits, because he believes Wikipedia should be edited by experts
- Thinks editing is time consuming ("laborious"), particularly to create new content, find citations, or to edit on a topic he doesn't know about, even though he hasn't tried these tasks.

time working, and when he's not working or with his family, he writes on management practices for his Naver blog and meets potential clients over dinner or at professional events.

Tech Habits

He has a personal Windows laptop which he uses for his work and writing, and an iPhone which he uses frequently for business calls and to monitor and post on social media. He writes for his own Naver blog, which is among the top-rated business blogs on Naver. He also contributes to Naver forums on business and management, in an effort

to further promote his expertise. He uses the internet quite a bit for work, but it took him some time to learn how to customize his Naver blog. Now he moves fluidly between Naver and his various social media accounts, constantly updating his various online profiles.

Perceptions of Wikipedia

Gong-Yoo first learned about Korean Wikipedia 8 years ago. He finds it extremely useful for explaining new topics, and does research on both Korean and English Wikipedias often when writing about a new topic on his blog. He learned that

anyone could edit Wikipedia only recently, when he read about this in a news article. He knows that Wikipedia can be edited by amateurs, but doesn't know anything else about how editing works, and the related policies.

Experience Goals


 To add links and content from his work that will appear on Wikipedia instantly and publicly, without being disputed or removed

Experience Goals


